Jared,

As of today, the 100W HPS Open bottoms cost \$11.93 per month. There can be periodic rate increases. Two surcharges are added to each light, Electric Fuel Adjustment and an Environmental surcharge.

I have attached an example of the surcharges.

So, the price for 38 lights for 5 years, as of today, will be \$28,659.60.

\$11.93 + .64 =\$12.57 \$12.57x38 lights=\$477.66 \$477.66x60 months (5 years)=\$28,659.60
