BE IT ORDAINED BY THE LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL OF THE LOUISVILLE/JEFFERSON COUNTY METRO GOVERNMENT (THE COUNCIL) AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION I: The amount sum of \$1019,000 is hereby appropriated from District 5
Neighborhood Development Funds in the following manner: \$18,500 from District 5:
and \$250 each from Districts 16 and 17; through the Office of Management and Budget, to Portland Museum, Inc. for operating expenses, program expenses associated with Paper, Printing & Poetry: Book Arts Bind a Community to its Future, and capital expenditures.

SECTION II: The Council has determined the funds requested in this Ordinance will be expended for a public purpose.

SECTION III: This grant is subject to the Council's Policies and Procedures as adopted and effective at the date of passage of this Ordinance.

SECTION IV: This Ordinance shall take effect upon its passage and approval.
