


R-4 DIMENSIONAL STANDARDS

MINIMUM LOT AREA = 9,000 SFMINIMUM LOT WIDTH $= 60 \, \text{FT}.$

MINIMUM FRONT AND STREETSIDE SETBACK = 30 FT.MINIMUM SIDE YARDS (EACH) = 5 FT. MINIMUM REAR YARD SETBACK = 25 FT.MAXIMUM BUILDING HEIGHT = 35 FT.

1. A Waiver is requested from Section 7.3.30 of The Louisville Metro Land Development Code to waive the 15' Buffer Yard adjacent to the west and north property lines.

- 1. No lots shown hereon may be subdivided or resubdivided resulting in the creation of a greater number of lots than originally approved by the planning commission.
- 2. This development is located in the Highview Fire Protection District and approval shall be obtained prior to construction approval.
- 3. Construction fencing shall be erected at the edge of the limits of disturbance areas prior to any grading or construction activities. The fencing is to remain in place until all construction is completed. No parking, material storage, or construction activities shall be permitted within the fenced area.
- 4. A soil erosion and sedimentation control plan shall be developed and implemented in accordance with the Metropolitan Sewer District and USDA Soil Conservation Service recommendations.
- 5. All open space lots are non-buildable and will be recorded as open space and utility easements.
- 6. Compatible on—site utilities, (electric, phone, cable) shall be placed in a common trench unless otherwise required by appropriate agencies.
- 7. Mitigation measures for dust control shall be in place during construction to prevent fugitive particulate emissions form reaching existing roads and neighboring properties.
- 8. The Louisville Water Company will determine the width of their easement prior to construction plan
- 9. A Karst survey was conducted by Ann Richard RLA on August 8th, 2017 and no Karst features were

SEWER & DRAINAGE

- 1. Runoff from this development must be conveyed to an adequate public outlet.
- 2. No portion of the site is located in a floodplain per FIRM map 21111C0113E dated December 5, 2006.
- 3. Sewers by L. E. and subject to all applicable fees.
- 4. A "Request for Sanitary Sewer Capacity" has been filed with MSD on August 3, 2017.
- 5. All proposed sewer and drain easements shall be 15' unless otherwise indicated. 6. Wastewater: Sanitary sewer will connect to the Cedar Creek Wastewater Treatment Plant by lateral
- extension agreement, subject to fees. 7. During construction plan phase the developer will grade lots 76-78 for swales in between lots.
- 8. The final design of this project must meet all MS4 water quality regulations established by MSD. Site layout may change at the design phase due to proper sizing of Green Belt Management Practices.
- 9. ACOE and KYTC approval required prior to MSD construction plan approval.
- 10. On—site detention will be provided. Post—developed flows will be limited to pre—developed peak flows for the 2,10,25 & 100 year storms or to the capacity of the downstream system, whichever is more

STREETS & SIDEWALKS

- 1. All roads within the development shall have curb and gutters.
- 2. Street grades shall not be less than 1% (Min.) or 10% (max.).
- 3. All streets, intersections, loop roads, cul—de—sacs, bulbs, traffic circles and rights—of—way shall be in accordance with the Development Code and Metro Public Works' standards and approved at the time of
- 4. All street name signs shall conform with the MUTCD requirements and shall be installed prior to the recording of the applicable subdivision plat or prior to obtaining the first certificate of occupancy and shall be in place at time of bond release.
- 5. The location and type of plantings within the street right—of—way will be evaluated for roadway safety and sight distance requirements by Metro Public Works which reserves the right to remove them without the property owner's approval.
- 6. Should any existing drainage structures and/or utilities located within offsite rights—of—way become necessary to be altered, extended or relocated, such shall be at the owner's/developer's expense.
- 7. A Bond and Encroachment Permit will be required by Metro Works for roadway repairs within the site due
- to damage caused by construction traffic activities. 8. Verges shall be provided as required by Metro Public Works.
- 9. Sidewalk & Pavement widths will be provided in accordance with Chapter 6 of the Land Development Code.
