Good Morning Councilmembers -

Councilman Blackwell and Councilwoman Hamilton have been contacted by Metro Parks for support of their annual Canoemobile event at Shawnee and Riverview Parks.

The schedule of events is more extensive than ever this year with three educational programming days as well as two days of free and open canoeing at Riverview and Shawnee Parks (please see the schedule provided by Rebecca in the below email).

The funding request is for the cost of Wildnerness Inquiry, Inc. to assist with the program, busses for the three schools and some marketing expense. As Rebecca explains below, the two open days at Shawnee and Riverview are free and open to all, but the event is part of Parks' effort to connect residents in West and South Louisville with outdoor recreation along our beautiful Ohio River.

Dear Councilman Blackwell and Councilwoman Hamilton.

Thank you for your past support of initiatives involving Jefferson Memorial Forest including our effort to expand access to nature for children and families through our community-oriented outdoor recreation and educational programs. Special thanks for all that both of you have done to help build the annual Canoemobile event.

This year Canoemobile is expanding to include three education days in addition to our public days. Every 4th grade student in three ECHO schools Chenoweth (District 9), Portland (District 5), and Coral Ridge (District 13), will have the chance to take a canoe trip on the Ohio River. In addition, JMF staff and JCPS teachers will provide hands-on education programming that enhances the classroom science curriculum. As a part of Louisville ECHO and our West Louisville Outdoor Recreation Initiative, Canoemobile helps connect more people—particularly from Southwest and West Louisville—to nature. The Jefferson Memorial Forest staff has been working to provide more and more opportunities to connect people from all over the city to nature, particularly youth and families in underserved areas. Safe and secure access to canoeing on the Ohio is a part of that goal, and Canoemobile helps us to provide that.

- Wed., Oct. 4, 10-2 at Riverview Park: Portland Elementary School Education Day
- Thurs., Oct. 5, 10-2 at Riverview Park: Coral Ridge Elementary School Education Day
- Fri., Oct. 6, 10-4 at Shawnee Park: Public Day (free and open to all)
- Sat., Oct. 7, 10-4 at Riverview Park: Public Day (free and open to all)

Support for these efforts come from multiple sources, and we've appreciated past support from Metro Council which has helped us leverage funds from the United States Forest Service and private organizations. This year, we are happy to report that we have received \$3,500 in funding from the U.S. Forest Service to cover some costs of this year's Canoemobile, in addition to an in-kind contribution from JMF of staffing and supplies. Below is this year's proposed cost share.

As you can see, we would like to request \$6,000 from Metro Council for the five days of Canoemobile. This covers the cost of bringing our national partner, Wilderness Inquiry, Inc. to town to assist with the program, as well as busses for the three schools, and some marketing expenses. The Canoemobile is open to all and marketed across the city, but is part of Metro Parks' effort to promote the wonderful potential for outdoor recreation along the Ohio River in West and Southwest Louisville. It helps to get people in these areas out connecting to their local parks and participating in healthy

activities. For about 80% of our participants this is their first time in a Canoe. Now in its sixth year, we see many return participants as well as many first-timers.

We hope you will consider continuing your critical support for this program and we hope that other affected council members might consider support the effort as has been the case in past years.
