

Christa,

The Baseball Alley is complex. It is an asphalt alley with a concrete roll curb running down the center to provide drainage. If we attempted to remove just the asphalt, I am not sure how well the concrete would hold up, so I must account for replacement of the entire roll curb since it appears to be in poor condition already. With that said, I would recommend replacing the concrete curb in the middle of the road with just asphalt and sloping appropriately to the catch basins to provide a smoother ride. In addition to this, there are 4 sidewalk ramps which will need to be updated. Finally, I want to inform you that there are asphalt parking spots which abut up to the alley that are property of Friendship House of Lou, INC but we cannot repave those spaces since it is a private property.



With a lot of unknowns regarding the final scope of work, my estimate is rather high to repave this alley coming in at \$25,000.00.
