

Please see the estimate for Chenoweth Run Right Turn Lane for approximately \$63,000. The contractor doesn't want to do the work without construction staking so we'll need QK4 to survey this for us. Once we give the Surveyor the go ahead it will take 3 weeks to develop a survey, a week for me to develop plans, then a week to construct depending when Louisville Paving can get it on their schedule, so the schedule is tight for us to get it done before winter.
