## RESPONSE TO RESPONDENT'S MOTION FOR ADMISSION OF PHOTOGRAPHIC EVIDENCE

Comes the Charging Committee, by counsel, and objects to the Respondent's Motion for admission of certain photographic evidence. Their introduction will be irrelevant and will not provide the Council Court with the necessary evidence to decide the charges filed. The proposed evidence will needlessly delay and divert the Council Court from hearing important evidence.

The photographs submitted with the Motion do not prove anything regarding the events at Wyandotte Park except to rebut Respondent's statements in his August 24, 2017 Response to Charges that Councilman Johnson's touching of Jessica Green took place "in front of approximately 1,000 witnesses," and that Respondent's touching occurred as "the group crowded together for a photograph." It is clear in these photos that, at best, a couple dozen witnesses were at Wyandotte Park, and that Councilman Johnson was not part of a crowd of people struggling to fit into a photo.

The Respondent has not met his burden to prove the relevancy and necessity permitting the introduction of the proposed photographic evidence. The Charging Committee respectfully requests that this Motion be overruled.
