Present, Hon James P. Gregory Judge

An instrument of writing purporting to be the last will and testament of Anna Maria Wahl, deceased, late of this County, was produced in Court and, proved by the testimony of Anton Lehman one of the subscribing witnesses thereto, who also proved the signature of H. A. Rademaker the other subscribing witness thereto, whereupon the same was established by the Court to be the last will and testament of said testatrix and ordered to be recorded.

This day came Adolph Wahl the Executor named in the last will and testament of Anna Maria Wahl, deceased, late of this County, who made oath according to law; execution of said will is granted him, whereupon he executed bond as required by law, without surety, as required in said will, which said bond is duly stamped as required by Act of Congress.

This day came B. C. Hubbard and produced and filed in Court his commission from the Governor of this Commonwealth appointing him Notary Public in and for Jefferson County; his commission bears date November the 19<sup>th</sup> year of 1898 and expires at the end of the next term of Court, whereupon he took the oath and executed bond as required by law, with C. Kellogg as his surety, which said bond is duly stamped as required by Act of Congress.

The Court grants unto George W. Hammel, a duly authorized Minister of the Gospel a license to solemnize the rites of matrimony, whereupon he took the oath and executed bond as required by law, with C. R. Crowe as his surety, which said bond is duly stamped as required by Act of Congress.

This day came Sarah J. Moore a minor child of E. C. Moore, and over fourteen years of age, personally into Court and chose The Louisville Trust Co as her guardian, which was appointed accordingly.

On motion of Edward Reider, father of the infant Edward Reider, under fourteen years of age, the Court appoints The Louisville Trust Co guardian of said infant Edward Reider.

On motion of Enoch mother of the infant Daniel Enoch under fourteen years of age and orphan of Henry Enoch, the Court appoints The Louisville Trust Co guardian of said infant Daniel Enoch.

In re - assigned estate of Alon Block.

Came assignor Alon Block by Counsel attorney and filed his statement herein.

In re - estate of Stanley - Everett Building Co assigned.

In motion of assignee and assignor herein by Counsel attorney it is ordered by the Court that John C. Reiss be and is appointed appraiser herein in behalf of Charles Braggith, therefore came said John C. Reiss and took the oaths required to law as such appraiser appraiser.

Ordered that Dennis J. Coleman William Lynch, and John Rothstein owners two of them after being first duly sworn do appraise the personal estate of Francis Conniffe, deceased, and report to Court.

In Re - Assessment of E. R. Gray.

This day came Robert E. Hordel Revenue Agent for Jefferson County, Ky and suggested to the Court that the hereinafter described land herein mentioned from assessments for State and County purposes for the year 1894. Then came Just S. Ray every James American, title to the owner of and bought and admitted to the Court the liability thereof for assessment for said year, and the assessable value thereof and the Court being advised adjudged that said land assessable for assessment for said year, and fixed the fair cash value thereof at \$5000. Said land is described as follows: 40x150 W 3 East Catletts & Holland.

In re - estate of Paul O'Connell deceased.

Came John H. Miller Administrator of aforesaid estate and filed report of sale herein.

The Appraiser's report and Inventory of the estate of said Paul O'Connell deceased was this day returned filed and ordered to be recorded.

In re - estate of Richard Mathews deceased.

Came John H. Miller Public Administrator to whom was referred aforesaid estate and filed report of sale herein.

The Inventory and Appraisal of the personal estate of Robert S. Mathews deceased, was this day returned filed and ordered to be recorded.

In re - Petition to grant probate.

This day came J. Gunn and filed herein an agreement signed by John Gross, H. L. Coose, J. J. Blankenbaker, L. A. Blankenbaker and James Dugger Esq,

Not true, John Rose, J. J. Goss, Harry Rankin & Jones and their heirs, inhabitants of Jefferson County and County road the tract of land thirty (30) feet in width as shown by the map filed herein June 24<sup>th</sup> 1895 said road beginning at the corner to Newell and Ellingsworth running thence along the line of Rankin's cedar and pine trees to the Newell Blanks' corner thence to the N.W. of J. J. Blanks' corner and Rankin's to Jones, thence with Jones' Blanks' corner northward over here to corner to Jones' line and thence west with Jones' forest line and Kate Snyder to John Rose, thence with John Rose and Kate Snyder line and thence from Rose and H. S. Jones' land formerly owned by Mr. Jones to the County road and it appearing to the Court that all parties in interest have consented to and joined in said dedication and record said County road and all claims for damages of any kind by reason of taking of said land for said purpose or for breaking of fence, or other damages, etc., are hereinafter held adjudged that said road be opened and kept in good repair and well dedicated on condition that the petitioners shall apply to the said road for the costs of this procedure and the costs of clearing said road and putting the same in condition for travel. J. J. Goss is hereby authorized on behalf of the petitioners to open said roadway, as dedicated, but his compensation, if any, shall be paid by the petitioners.

On the matter of the last will and testament of Sarah Johnson deceased.

In virtue of John G. Sieber the testator named in the instrument heretofore produced in Court and purporting to be the last will and testament of Sarah A. Johnson deceased, by his Counsel Mr. Max and it appearing to the Court that Sarah Max one of the subscribing witnesses thereto is now residing and domiciled at Clark County, Mo. It is therefore ordered by the Court that at Commission issue to take the deposition of said witness thereto.

The Court consents to the transfer of State license #W 890 from D. O. Smallwood to John Feder, authorizing him to sell spirituous and malt liquors at the location named therein until the expiration thereof.

Ordered that Court stand adjourned until to-morrow morning at 10 o'clock.
