

Variance Justification:

In order to justify approval of any variance, the Board of Zoning Adjustment considers the following criteria. Please answer all of the following items. Use additional sheets if needed. A response of yes, no, or N/A is not acceptable.

1. Explain how the variance will not adversely affect the public health, safety or welfare.

This variance primarily addresses an existing site condition (existing garage moved forward on the lot) to allow for rear addition to be built. No tree will be removed during this process. All new structure will be between existing garage and new fence.

The addition on the rear of the home will be in line with how normal rear additions would be designed and built. However, because of the rear yard condition with existing garage, this variance will be required for private rear yard.

The private rear yard requirement intention can be met with the substantial green space on the left and right side of the property as well as behind the existing fence line. Additionally, all trees will remain.

4. Explain how the variance will not allow an unreasonable circumvention of the requirements of the zoning regulations.

This variance will allow for the modest addition to the rear of an existing home, which is generally allowed within zoning requirements.
