Statement:

The Artist-in-Residence program has proven to be a meaningful, successful endeavor for South Central. The average attendance for artist programs to date is approximately 20 participants – reaching over 350 people at programs since inception. Patrons, particularly children and teens have been excited, inspired, and intrigued by the varied artists who have held residencies since July. Many of these patrons have indicated that interactions with artists, and participation in their workshops, are their only opportunity to engage in creative endeavors.

Currently, artists are allotted a \$200 supply budget for their residency. Because we do not have an existing store of artist-quality supplies, most artists are using their supply budget to purchase the basics needed to perform their work. By providing artists with these basic supplies upfront, they can focus their supply budget on purchases that will enhance the quality of workshops and programs. This will directly benefit the patron. Additionally, it would not be feasible for artists to purchase some of these items with their supply budget – such as a digital camera, photo printer, a store of handheld field records, and headphones. However, these items will certainly improve the overall quality of the programming we can provide patrons.

We are already gaining traction within the artistic community in making this an appealing opportunity. We saw a 26% increase in applications from our 2017 to 2018 applicants, even with a decreased application period from four months to one. An added benefit to making these purchases is to make the residency even more enticing for future artists who consider applying for the program.

I am convinced that by creating this artist supply closet, we will improve the quality of the artist-in-residence program – both for the artists, and for our patrons.

South Central Regional Library is also offering sewing classes as part of the Collider Maker Lab. There is a weekly program offered for teens and a monthly program offered for adults. Staff members will be working to increase the class offerings through 2018 as a response to the popularity of the classes. Additional sewing machines, assorted other tools, and a consumable supply budget will allow the classes to expand and further meet the needs of our community. Not only would we like to expand class offerings, we would also like to offer open lab hours. These lab hours would allow patrons to come in and work on their own projects with our equipment.

In addition to the proposed budget for an artist supply closet and expanded sewing equipment, I am also proposing a budget for an end of year artist showcase in December 2018. This afterhours special event would bring together the artists from 2017-2018 for a display of artwork and a showcase of performances. The showcase would be an excellent opportunity to bring attention to the Collider Artist in Residence Program at the South Central Regional Library. A budget of \$1,000-\$1,500 would allow ample funds to provide displays, refreshments, and any accompaniments that the artists require.
