NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD MEMBERS OF THE LOUISVILLE AND JEFFERSON COUNTY LANDBANK AUTHORITY, INC.,

SECTION 1. That the Board Members of the Louisville and Jefferson County Landbank Authority, Inc. hereby authorize the sale of the following described properties:

SECTION 2. That the Chairman of the Louisville and Jefferson County Landbank Authority, Inc., or his designee, is hereby authorized and directed to transfer the properties listed herein in the manner provided according to KRS 65.370, to Habitat for Humanity of Metro Louisville, Inc., for construction of single-family residences, without further action by the Authority.

SECTION 3. That the single-family residences shall be constructed within eighteen (18) months of acquiring the properties; and the applicant shall return the subject properties to the Authority if single-family residences are not constructed within eighteen (18) months; such requirements being included and recorded as a deed restriction.

SECTION 4. That this Resolution shall become effective upon its passage and approval.
