Gas station and medical office planned for former Meadowview Presbyterian Church site in Hikes Point

The heavily trafficked corner at Taylorsville Road and Breckenridge Lane in the heart of Hikes Point is likely to get busier.

Plans have been filed for a two-story, 24,000-square-foot medical office that will have a companion 5,100-square-foot convenience store with a 16-pump service island at 2944 Breckenridge. The site is where Meadowview Presbyterian Church was recently demolished.

Preliminary plans were disclosed recently for Advanced ENT & Allergy to build the medical office on the nearly four-acre site that it newly owns. But the plans for the adjacent large service center were revealed in a new filing with metro regulators. New details on the office project were also disclosed in the filing.

Glenn Price Jr., the attorney for the property owner, said negotiations are not final for what petroleum chain will operate the service center. Price also represents Thorntons, but he said the service center could be another company.

He said it isn't certain whether Advanced ENT will subdivide and sell off a part of the tract for the service center, or whether it will lease that part of the site.

The target tract is across from a now-empty Kmart location and just north of the busy Taylorsville-Breckenridge intersection. Price said that some transportation improvements are also not yet final.

The documents indicate that a change from residential to commercial zoning will be sought to develop the property.

The Louisville Presbytery, which holds title to most of the property occupied by Presbyterian churches in this area, sold the site at 2944 Breckenridge last year to Advanced ENT Holdings for \$2.2 million, according to Jefferson property valuation office records. The church was demolished, and the congregation is now meeting at another location.

The medical firm now has its main offices at 4004 DuPont Circle in St. Matthews. It has other locations in Louisville and Southern Indiana and was created by the merger of three ear, nose and throat organizations. The website said the merged firm has more than a dozen ear, nose and throat specialists.
