WHEREAS, the Metro Government wishes to enter into this agreement through the Department of Public Works & Assets.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL OF THE LOUISVILLE/JEFFERSON COUNTY METRO GOVERNMENT (THE COUNCIL) AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION I: The Mayor is hereby authorized to enter into an agreement with the Commonwealth of Kentucky Transportation Cabinet to combine three separate Olmsted Parkways Bicycle and Pedestrian Facilities grant awards into one award with a balance of \$1,869,532.34 in CMAQ funds. Along with the original Eastern Parkway route, the revised scope of work is to construct a multi-use trail along Olmsted Parkways in Louisville.

SECTION II: This Resolution shall take effect upon its passage and approval.
