STATUTORY AUTHORITY	KRS 90.110230

ORDINANCE AUTHORITY1 LMGO 32.300 - 304

POWERS It shall have all of the duties and responsibilities as outlined in KRS Chapter 90 et seq. All powers, duties, obligations and responsibilities of the former Louisville. Civil Service Board shall be transferred to the Board and it shall be organized and operated in conformity with KRS Chapter 90.

Any member of the board may be removed by the mayor, for cause, after hearing by the mayor, and after at least ten (10) days' notice in writing has been given to the member, which notice shall contain a copy of charges preferred against him. At the hearing he may be represented by counsel. The finding of the mayor shall be final and removal results in vacancy in such office.

MEETING At least one regular meeting in each month and additional meetings as necessary.

OFFICERS	Board shall elect a chairman and a vice chairman from its members, and the personnel director shall be the secretary treasurer.
FISCAL AGENT AGREEMENT WITH METRO?	Yes
HOW IS THE DIRECTOR OR EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR APPOINTED/HIRED?	Not specified, but the board is authorized and empowered to employ such persons as may be necessary and proper for the efficient conduct of its activities hereunder. The board may fix the compensation to be paid such employees, in accordance with the schedule of salaries established, or that may be established, by ordinance. The board shall employ a personnel director who shall be the administrative officer of the board. The personnel director shall be, at the time of appointment, a person familiar, and in sympathy, with the principles, and experienced in the methods and technique, of personnel administration on the merit basis and a person of recognized character and ability.
RECORDS & REPORTS	Shall keep full and complete minutes of its proceedings, which minutes shall subject to reasonable regulations, be open to public inspection.

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EX OFFICIO MEMBERS	Mayor - serves as the 7th member, but can only vote to break a tie
COMPENSATION	Each member of the board may be paid a salary not to exceed a per diem, allowance to be fixed from time to time by ordinance of the board of aldermen, for each meeting attended, provided, however, that the annual allowance of any one (1) member of the board shall not exceed the maximum sum fixed by the ordinance of the board of aldermen in any one (1) fiscal year, and in addition thereto members shall be reimbursed for necessary travel and other expenses incurred in connection with their duties as members. \$50 per meeting or hearing attended, but no more than \$10,800 in any fiscal year for entire Board.

VACANCY APPOINTMENT DETAILS	Vacancies created by death, resignation and otherwise shall be filled for the unexpired portion of the term only.
QUORUM	Not stated
HOW APPOINTED	Mayor appoints 6
QUALIFICATION OF MEMBERS	Must be selected equally from the 2 political parties casting the highest and next highest number of votes in the preceding general election. Cannot be an appointed officer of City while a member or for 1 year thereafter, if member becomes a candidate for elective office, he thereby vacates his position as a member of the board.
