Dear Seventh Division Council Members,

As you are aware, the Seventh Division is the largest geographical police division in the Louisville Metro covering an expansive 111 square miles. The Seventh Division includes a large number of parks, lakes, farmland, and rural territories. As law enforcement, it is our duty and responsibility to provide the highest level of service possible for the community regardless of the type of terrain. As part of that commitment, I humbly request your assistance with the purchase of two All-Terrain Vehicles (ATVs). ATVs would enable us to provide a police presence and enforcement in areas otherwise inaccessible to standard patrol practices. These vehicles are flexible, durable, and versatile while able to traverse all types of landscapes. ATVs are highly maneuverable, relatively quiet, and provide the ability to respond to and support special events and calls for service. They are crucial for search and rescue missions and facilitate an immediate response for improved lifesaving measures. A structured ATV program as an alternative patrol method allows for greater community contact and interaction strengthening the police and community partnership. Each council district in the Seventh Division stands to benefit from the purchase of these resources. I have included an itemized quote for the purchase of two ATVs from a city approved vendor. The vehicles will be maintained and serviced by LMPD Fleet Services.

Thank you very much for your continued service and supportive involvement in facilitating positive community interaction between citizens and law enforcement. I truly appreciate your consideration of this important investment to enhance public safety in the Seventh Division.
