Please confirm our conversation – if we add an additional \$159,000 and combine the FY19 funding into one project, it would fund:

- 1. Springhurst from Hurstbourne to White Blossom
- 2. Springhurst from White Blossom to Towne Center Rd
- 3. 4 sections of White Blossom from Hurstbourne to Springhurst (including the 3 cul-de-sacs off White Blossom)
- 4. Murphy Lane from Westport Rd to Hallifax

This would combine FY19 Republican pool funding of \$75,000 for Springhurst from Westport to Town Center Drive (and this section would not be done?) and \$120,000 for Murphy Lane from Westport to Hallifax and \$159,000 new funding from D17 CIF as well as the \$xxx PW&A funding for 4 sections of White Blossom Blvd outlined in the FY19 paving plan for a total of \$xxxxx(?)

Beth,

Per conversations with D17, we will be paving Springhurst from Hurstbourne to White Blossom with the money appropriated. Additionally, please combine Murphy Ln and Springhurst Blvd paving moneys into a single account if possible as we can then balance the spending as necessary for both projects. If overages are encountered for both projects, Public Works will cover those excess costs.

Per our conversations, it looks like the next section of Springhurst from White Blossom to Towne Center Rd would cost \$160,000.00 to complete. It sounds like D17 has just about this much to allocate. If they choose to allocate towards this project, our contractor would be able to complete work scheduled for late next week, early the following week. I would recommend extending the paving on Springhurst in-lieu of Murphy Ln at this time.
