A: Describe the program/project start and end dates, a description of the program/project and applicable data with regards to specific client population the program will address (attach related flyers, planning minutes, designs, event permits, proposals for services/goods, etc.):

The Historic Old Louisville Neighborhood and Visitors Center serves a two fold purpose. First, it serves as a community meeting place for neighborhood associations and community partners. The OLNC member neighborhood associations meet regularly at the center for the business meetings. Receptions are held at the center by community partners such as the St. James Court Art Show and Kentucky Shakespeare, as well as Jazz in Central Park.

Secondly, the Visitors Center serves as the gateway for visitors to the historic district of Old Louisville. We work closely with the Louisville Convention and Visitors Bureau to draw out of town visitors and group tours to the Victorian mansion district of Old Louisville. The Historic Old Louisville Walking Tours are operated out of the Visitors Center April-October each year providing a guided 75 minute architectural and historical walking tour of the heart of the mansion district. Local residents also come to the visitors center and take the tours as well, for example the UofL University Club members are planning to take the walking tours in 2019.

B: Describe specifically how the funding will be spent including identification of funding to sub grantee(s): The funds for the Historic Old Louisville Visitors Center will be used for the marketing efforts to promote the historic district and the walking tours. Funds will be used for printing the Historic Old Louisville Walking Tour booklet - a 48 page color booklet which describes the architecture and history of the buildings in the preservation district. This booklet is given to each tour attendee. Funds will also defray the cost of the graphic design services to revise the booklet and create marketing collateral, such as rack cards which will be distributed to the Louisville Visitors Center downtown, downtown area hotels and attractions, as well as community partners such as the Conrad Caldwell House Museum, the Filson Historical Society, the Asia Institute Crane House, and the University of Louisville Visitor Services, which help promote the tours. The funds will also be used to cover printing costs of the rack cards and posters to promote the walking tours, as well as any events that are included at the Visitors Center, such as free concerts.

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E: Describe the program's benefits to those being served (measurable outcomes). Include the program's process for collecting data and the indicators that will be tracked to measure the benefits to those being served:

The Historic Old Louisville Neighborhood and Visitors Center serves as a community center for the 12,000 residents of Old Louisville. The 14 neighborhood associations use the center for meetings and events. Attendance can be tracked for each meeting and provided to the administrative assistant who can keep a running tally.

The Old Louisville Neighborhood Council tracks the visitors to the Historic Old Louisville Visitors Center during its days of operation. In 2015 the Center had only 1,890 visitors. In 2016, there were 3005. In 2017, there were 3000. In 2018, with better marketing for the walking tours, there is a clear uptick in visitors and we are now offering walking tours twice a day and on demand when staff is available. The Historic Old Louisville Walking Tours have become a steady revenue stream for the OLNC. Guided walking tour sales have average \$1200 per month. We can track sales with the Square-Up Merchant Services. With the addition and marketing of the new LOU LIFT service we are anticipating greater numbers of walking tour attendees.

We also participate in the Fund for the Arts Cultural Pass each year to offer JCPS students and their parents the opportunity to take a guided walking tour of Historic Old Louisville. We track our participants through the google doc that the the FFA uses.

F: Briefly describe any existing collaborative relationships the organization has with other community organizations. Describe what those partners are bringing to the relationship in general and to this program/project specifically.

Generally, the Old Louisville Neighborhood Council is always expanding its community partnerships. The OLNC spearheaded the Old Louisville Arts Council with area arts organizations to collaborate and cross promote events. The OLAC includes: OLNC, Kentucky Shakespeare, U of L, Ky College of Art and Design, St. James Court Art Show, Garvin Gate Blues Festival, The Conrad Caldwell House Museum, The Filson Historical Society, Asia Institute Crane House, and the Louisville Free Public Library. In addition, the OLNC has spearheaded an Old Louisville Business Alliance of area businesses in Old Louisville to work more collaboratively and proactively to solve problems. The organizations participating to date include: Luckett-Farley; SOBRO district businesses; Dan Borsch restaurants Tavern, Burger Boy, Old Louisville Pizza, and Toonerville Deli; Bridgehaven; McCulloch Architects; Craig Machinery and Design; Grover Enterprises; Christian Care Communities; Hyland Insurance; Family and Children's Place; Barrister Hall Attorneys; Community Coordinated Child Care; Westerfield-Barre Co; Synergy Rehabilitation: Aztec Flooring; Old Louisville Brewery; Mary Martin Semonin Realtor; Old Louisville Fleur de Lis Bed and Breakfast; Louisville Bourbon Inn; Virtue; Gallery 133; Amici Cafe; Sabor Latino; Seafood Lady, St. James Court Art Show.

In this program specifically we work collaboratively with the University of Louisville Visitor Services to promote the tours. We work closely with the Louisville Convention and Visitors Bureau to promote Old Louisville as a heritage tourism destination to group tours. We promote the walking tours through the Louisville Visitors Center downtown. We work with area attractions and hotels to provide information on the historic district and the walking tours. We work with area restauranteurs to promote their businesses as part of the experience for out of town visitors to Old Louisville. We work with the Conrad Caldwell House

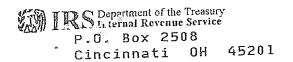

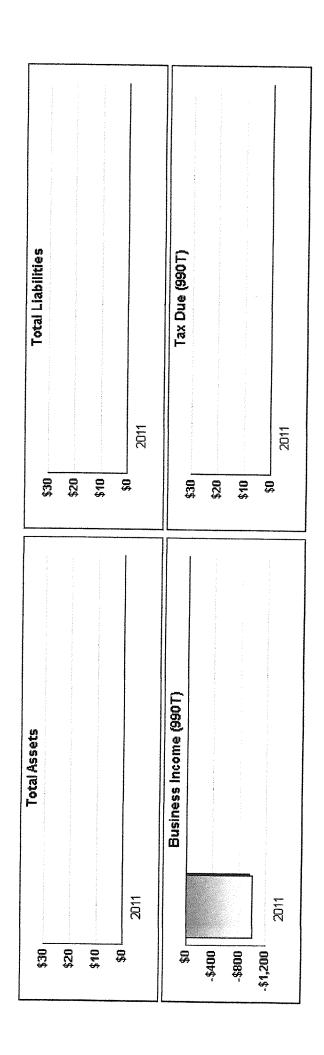

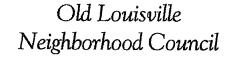

OF

THE OLD LOUISVILLE INFORMATION CENTER, INC.

I, THE UNDERSIGNED, for the purpose of forming a non-profit, non-stock corporation, under and pursuant to the laws of the Commonwealth of Kentucky, and more particularly Chapter 273 of the Kentucky Revised Statutes, hereby certify as follows:

ARTICLE I

The name of the Corporation shall be:

THE OLD LOUISVILLE INFORMATION CENTER, INC.

ARTICLE II

The duration of the Corporation shall be perpetual.

ARTICLE III

The principal place of business of the Corporation is to be located at 1340 So. Fourth Street (in Central Park), Louisville, Kentucky, 40208 and such other places in said city or elsewhere as its Board of Directors may by resolution designate.

ARTICLE IV

The Corporation is organized and shall be operated exclusively for charitable and educational purposes within the meaning of Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1954 (or corresponding provisions of any later Federal tax laws), including

for such purposes the making of distributions to organizations and individuals for the purpose of engaging in activity falling within the purposes of the Corporation and permitted for an organization exempt under said Section 501(c)(3).

The purposes of the Corporation shall be more specifically

stated as follows:

1) To operate a resource center for the residents of the Old Louisville neighborhood which will provide a wide variety of educational material, information, and other services to help them meet social, health, welfare, educational and cultural needs.

2) To engage in educational and charitable activity designed to lessen neighborhood tensions and to encourage and pro-

mote community cooperation and pride.

To engage in educational and charitable activity designed to combat neighborhood deterioration and to promote com-

munity revitalization and development.

4) To encourage, promote, and provide activity for neighborhood youth designed to instill in them a friendly and cooperative spirit and to advance their educational and cultural development.

ARTICLE V

The Corporation shall be irrevocably dedicated to and operated exclusively for, non-profit purposes. No part of the net arnings of the Corporation shall inure to the benefit of or be distributable to its members, directors, officers, or other private persons, except that the Corporation shall be authorized and empowered to pay reasonable compensation for services rendered and to make payments and distributions in furtherance of the purposes set forth in Article IV hereof.

ARTICLE VI

The Corporation shall be empowered to do all acts reasonable and necessary and within the laws of the State of Kentucky, in particular those enumerated in KRS 273.171, to further its purposes set out in Article IV, except as follows and as otherwise stated in these Articles:

a) No substantial part of the activities of the Corporation shall be the carrying on of propaganda, or otherwise attempting to influence legislation, and the Corporation shall not participate in, or intervene in (including the publishing or distribution of statements), any political campaign on behalf of any candidate for public office.

- b) Notwithstanding, any other provision of these Articles, the Corporation shall not carry on any other activities not permitted to be carried on by a corporation exempt from Federal income tax under Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1954 or the corresponding provisions of any subsequent Federal tax laws. If and so long as the Corporation is a private foundation as defined in Section 509(a) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1954, or corresponding provisions of any later Federal tax laws:
 - 1) The Corporation shall distribute its income for each taxable year at such time and in such manner as not to become subject to the tax on undistributed income imposed by Section 4942 of the Internal Revenue Code of 1954, or corresponding provisions of any later Federal tax laws.
 - 2) The Corporation shall not engage in any act of self-dealing as defined in Section 4941(d) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1954, or corresponding provisions of any later Federal tax laws.
 - 3) The Corporation shall not retain any excess business holdings as defined in Section 4943(c) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1954, or corresponding provisions of any later Federal tax laws.
 - 4) The Corporation shall not make any investments in such manner as to subject it to tax under Section 4944 of the Internal Revenue Code of 1954, or corresponding provisions of any later Federal tax laws.
 - 5) The Corporation shall not make any taxable expenditures as defined in Section 4945(d) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1954, or corresponding provisions of any later Federal tax laws.
