Case Summary/Background

- As the dwelling unit is located in the Old Louisville/Limerick TNZD, a Conditional Use Permit is required
- Located on the east side of S. Brook Street between St. Joseph and E.
 Oak Streets
- Adjoined by single- and multi-family residential uses
- Primary residence has four bedrooms; LDC regulations permit up to 12 guests
- LDC regulations require one parking space for the residence
 - one on-street space
 - two off-street parking spaces off rear alley
- Neighborhood meeting held September 27, 2018





Required Action

Approve or Deny

- <u>Conditional Use Permit</u> to allow short term rental of a dwelling unit located in the Old Louisville/Limerick TNZD (LDC 4.2.63)
- Conditions of Approval
 - 1. Prior to commencement of any short term rental on the subject property, the host shall register the short term rental with Develop Louisville and with the Louisville Metro Revenue Commission. If the short term rental is not registered with Develop Louisville and with the Revenue Commission within 60 days of the approval of the minutes of this case, then the Conditional Use Permit shall be deemed null and void.
 - 2. The short term rental and host shall meet all additional provisions set forth in the Louisville Metro Code of Ordinances.
