Attached is a conceptual drawing for adding (3) pickleball courts in Hounz Lane Park. This will be adjacent to the tennis courts, which will remain, and compliment the Parks offered amenities in the Park. I spoke with a court building contractor about the estimated probable cost. They, and I believe, the cost to construct will be between \$55,000 and \$65,000. That would include the new courts as well as a concrete sidewalk that would be the accessible route from the parking lot to the pickleball courts. 
