PURPOSE

The general purpose and function of the contrelssion shall include, but not be limited to, the following specific purposes and functions:

(1) To collect and analyze data on the incidence and nature of crime in this community and assess the impact of criminal activities upon the critices and recovery of the constructors.

(2) To evaluate the causably of commat justice and public safety aguncies through a careful study of existing laws, practicus, and institutions to recognize their areas of strength and weathness, and to formulate proposals to maintain the former and contect the latter.

(3) To make and publish, from time to time, meaningful documented factural recommendations as will be of assistance to all levels and manches of government in meeting as responsibilities in the area of criminal justice, public safety, and crime prevention.

(4) To responsibly samulate community interest in the problems of criminal justice subjects attety, and crime prevention.

(5) To develop and recommend to the proper commat justice and public safety authorities programs to enhance public safety, and, when possible, to secure and administer state or federal funds for specific projects.

(6) To recognize the authority and responsibility of criminal justice and public safety agencies as the proper areas of administration.


