BOARD DETAILS



Aid in disseminating among the people of Kentucky useful and practical info on agriculture, home economics, and rural and community life in conjunction with the director of the Kentucky cooperative extension service of the College of Agriculture of the University of Kentucky. An extension council is set up under regs approved by the director of extension. It has not less than 15 members and not more than 40. All members are appointed by groups and organizations of the county whose major interest is in agriculture and home economics such as farm bureaus, homemaker councils, 4-H club councils and other commodity groups.

POWERS

- 164,655 EXTENSION BOARD, POWERS AND DUTIES
- The extension board of each extension district shall have the following powers and duties:
- (1) To nerve as an agency of the Commonwealth and to manage and bansact all of the business and altalis of its district and have authority to acquire properly necessary for the conduct of the business of the district for the purposes of KRS 164,605 to 164,675.
- (2) To either into an annual memorandum of agreement with the extension service and the extension district. This memorandum of agreement shall set torth the policy pertuning to (a) appointment of personnel to serve in the district, (b) financing of extension work in the district, and (c) responsibilities of the cooperating parties in planning and executing the program;
- (3) To, and shall as soon as possible following the first meeting in which the officers are elected and annually thereafter, file in the office of the county clerk a conflictre aligned by its charmain and secretary certifying the names, addresses and terms of office of each member and the names and addresses of the officers of the extension board with the signatures of the officers attitud thursto, and said certificate shall be conclusive as to the organization of the extension district, its extension board and as to its members and its officers:
- (4) With the advice of the extension council, to make and educt duch rules and regulations not inconsistent with the law as it may deem necessary for its own government in the transaction of the business of the extension district.
- (5) To cooperate with the extension service and the extension council in conducting an extension program in agriculture, from economics, youth work and related subjects in the extension district. Said program shall be planted and executed upon the advice, recommendations and assistance of the extension council with the board to make final decisions.
- (6) To cooperate with other extension districts in the employment of personnel, conduct of programs and sponsorship of accivities for the nutural benefit of each.
 (7) To cooperate with all extension organizations, farm organizations, state and federal agencies, civic clubs and any other organizations who may be interested as and willing to cooperate in conducting the extension programs in the extension tension.
- (8) To presume annually not later than April 15 of each year in cooperation with the director of extension an extension district budget for the ensuing year. This

audget shall be prepared with consideration being given to the advice and recommendations of the extension council must be consistent with financing policies of the elements service and shall relict; the agricultural, home occurations, youth and related subject matter needs of people in the extension detect.

(P) To depose all distinct extension education funds in a bank or banks approved by it in the name of the extension distinct. These receipts shall condition a fund anown as the distinct proposative extension education fund which shall be distinct proposative extension board in accordance with the annual budget and the annual manufactured of agreement between the board and the extension servers.

(10) To, from time to time when necessary and on approval of the fiscal court, borrow such funds as may be required to meet the financial obligations of the extension district; provided, however, that the extension board carnot in any fiscal year incur indebtedness in a amount which would be in excess of the articipated revenue of said district for the fiscal year. The amount of the articipated revenue shall be certified to said board by the fiscal court of the county in which the district is located;

(11) To expand the district cooperative extension education fund for salaries and travel expense of extension personnel, rental office supplies, equipment, communications, office facilities, services and property acquisition and in payment of such other form as may be necessary to carry out the extension district program:

(12) To carry over unexpended district cooperative extension education funds into the next facal year so that tunds will be available to carry on the program; provided, however, that such enticipated carry-over funds small be taxen into consideration of the formulation of the extension district budget for the ensuing year.

(13) To file with the county hacal court or board of commissioners and directors of extension and to publish in one (1) newspaper of general enculation in the county before October 1 of each year a report under oath of all receipts and expenditures of such district cooperative extension education funds showing from whom received, to whom paid and for what purpose for the fast itself year:

(14) To be remunerated from the district cooperative extension aducation fund for actual expenses required in the performance of services for the extension district; provided, however, that payments for expenses must be approved by the extension board.

115) To accept contributions from hospic courts and bounds of education for use in conducting extension work in the extension district as provided for under KAS 247,080.

(16) To accept privite funds for use in conducting extension work in the extension distinct, provided, however, that the acceptance of all such commoditions must be approved by the director of extension; and

(17) To collect reasonable fees for specific services which require special equipment or personnel such as still testing services, seed testing services or other services in support of the educational program of the extension district.


