All,

I received the quote today for the cameras that we discussed for illegal dumping. The quote is for two cameras each and all accessories. The cost would be \$1602.90 per District. Here is the link for the cameras we recommend: http://www.reconyx.com/product/ultrafire-professional-covert-camera

When we talked last, we looked at possibly getting a camera that would allow us to utilize cellular if we wanted to activate it in the future. However, this camera does not have that option. It is strictly without cellular, but it has other qualities that we believe make it a better choice. The megapixel is better on these cameras which would allow us to zoom in on the images a bit better in hopes of reading a license plate on a vehicle that may be far from the camera. The nighttime infrared is also a bit better, and while it is not likely we would use it often they also allow for videos to be recorded instead of images alone. That could be beneficial in some areas.

Please let me know if you have any further questions or if you would like to move forward with the camera purchase.
