



Case Summary / Background

Zoned UN, Urban Neighborhood

 Conditional Use Permit to allow short term rental of a dwelling unit not the primary residence of the host (LDC 4.2.63)



Conditions of Approval

- 1. Prior to commencement of any short term rental on the subject property, the host shall register the short term rental with Develop Louisville and with the Louisville Metro Revenue Commission. If the short term rental is not registered with Develop Louisville and with the Revenue Commission within 60 days of the approval of the minutes of this case, then the Conditional Use Permit shall be deemed null and void.
- 2. The short term rental and host shall meet all additional provisions set forth in the Louisville Metro Code of Ordinances.
- 3. The maximum number of guests permitted in the short term rental shall be the lesser of six (6) per unit or that permitted by the Louisville Metro Code of Ordinances.
