SECTION I: The original sum of \$11,324.19 is hereby increased to \$22,252.35 and

appropriated from Neighborhood Development Funds in the following manner:

\$3,774.73 from Districts 7, 16, and 17 is increased to a total of \$7,417.45 for each of the

aforementioned Districts to Solid Waste Management Services to fund a community

recycling event held at Ballard High School on October 6, 2018.

SECTION II: The Council has determined the funds requested in this ordinance will be expended for a public purpose.

SECTION III: This grant is subject to the Council's Policies and Procedures as adopted and effective at the date of passage of this Ordinance.

SECTION IV: This Ordinance shall take effect upon its passage and approval.


