

I finally got this done today and here is what I found:

Whitmore alley – suggesting a 2 inch mill and overlay with fiber reinforced asphalt. There are 5 ramps I see which need to be replaced but I believe 1 will be technically infesible. See photo below of area. I estimate this alley can be completed for \$40,000.00 which does include reconstruction of the ramp at this time.
