1. BOUNDARY AND TOPOGRAPHIC SURVEY INFORMATION TAKEN FROM SURVEY BY BRYANT ASSOCIATES,

2. THERE SHALL BE NO INCREASE IN DRAINAGE RUN-OFF TO THE RIGHT OF WAY.

3. THE DEVELOPER SHALL BE RESPONSIBLE FOR ANY UTILITY RELOCATION ON THE PROPERTY. 4. THE DEVELOPMENT LIES IN LOUISVILLE #3 FIRE DISTRICT. CONSTRUCTION PLANS SHALL BE REVIEWED AND APPROVED BY THE LOUISVILLE #3 FIRE DISTRICT. A STATEMENT ON THE ADEQUACY OF ACCESS TO THE PROPERTIES SHALL BE OBTAINED FROM THE FIRE DISTRICT.

5. ALL DIMENSIONS SHOWN IN PAVED AREAS ARE FROM EDGE OF PAVEMENT TO EGDE OF PAVEMENT UNLESS SHOWN OTHERWISE.

6. ALL PARKING ISLANDS SHALL BE OUTLINED WITH CONCRETE MEDIAN CURB UNLESS NOTED OTHERWISE.

7. CONCRETE WALKS AND PAVING ARE TO HAVE LIGHT BROOM FINISH. 8. PROPOSED CORNER BUILDING SHALL BE LOCATED NO GREATER THAN 5' FROM THE PROPERTY LINE.

EPSC NOTES

1. THE APPROVED EROSION PREVENTION AND SEDIMENT CONTROL (EPSC) PLAN SHALL BE IMPLEMENTED PRIOR TO ANY LAND-DISTURBING ACTIVITY ON THE CONSTRUCTION SITE. ANY MODIFICATIONS TO THE APPROVED EPSC PLAN MUST BE REVIEWED AND APPROVED BY MSD'S PRIVATE DEVELOPMENT REVIEW OFFICE. EPSC BMP'S SHALL BE INSTALLED PER THE PLAN AND MSD STANDARDS. 2. ACTIONS MUST BE TAKEN TO MINIMIZE THE TRACKING OF MUD AND SOIL FROM CONSTRUCTION AREAS

ONTO PUBLIC ROADWAYS. SOILS TRACKED ONTO THE ROADWAY SHALL BE REMOVED DAILY. 3. SOIL STOCKPILES SHALL BE LOCATED AWAY FROM STREAMS, PONDS, SWALES, AND CATCH BASINS. STOCKPILES SHALL BE SEEDED, MULCHED, AND ADEQUATELY CONTAINED THROUGH THE USE OF SILT

FENCING. ALL STREAM CROSSINGS MUST UTILIZE LOW-WATER CROSSING STRUCTURES PER MSD STANDARD DRAWING ER-02. 4.WHERE CONSTRUCTION OR LAND DISTURBANCE ACTIVITY WILL OR HAS TEMPORARILY CEASED ON ANY

PORTION OF A SITE, TEMPORARY SITE STABILIZATION MEASURES SHALL BE REQUIRED AS SOON AS PRACTICABLE, BUT NO LATER THAN 14 CALENDAR DAYS AFTER THE ACTIVITY HAS CEASED. 5. SEDIMENT-LADEN GROUNDWATER ENCOUNTERED DURING TRENCHING, BORING OR OTHER EXCAVATION ACTIVITIES SHALL BE PUMPED TO A SEDIMENT TRAPPING DEVICE PRIOR TO BEING DISCHARGE INTO A STREAM, POND, SWALE OR CATCH BASIN.

4. INSTALL SEDIMENT TRAPS/BASIN IN NEW PARKING LOT AREA.

MSD NOTES

1. CONSTRUCTION PLANS AND DOCUMENTS SHALL COMPLY WITH LOUISVILLE AND JEFFERSON COUNTY METROPOLITAN SEWER DISTRICT'S DESIGN MANUAL AND STANDARD SPECIFICATIONS AND OTHER LOCAL, STATE AND FEDERAL

ORDINANCES. 2. SANITARY SEWERS AVAILABLE BY CONNECTION TO EXISTING SEWER. NO CAPACITY CHARGES APPLY. 3. SITE DISCHARGES INTO THE COMBINED SANITARY SEWER SYSTEM AND SHALL LIMIT THE 100-YEAR POST-DEVELOPED DISCHARGE TO THE 10-YEAR PRE-DEVELOPED DISCHARGE PER SECTION 10.3.1.2 OF THE MSD DESIGN MANUAL. 4. MITIGATION MEASURES FOR DUST CONTROL SHALL BE IN PLACE DURING CONSTRUCTION TO PREVENT FUGITIVE PARTICULATE EMISSIONS FROM REACHING EXISTING ROADS AND NEIGHBORING PROPERTIES

5. THE FINAL DESIGN OF THIS PROJECT MUST MEET ALL MS4 WATER QUALITY REGULATIONS ESTABLISHED BY MSD. SITE LAYOUT MAY CHANGE AT THE DESIGN PHASE DUE TO PROPER SIZING OF GREEN BEST MANAGEMENT PRACTICES. UNDERGROUND DETENTION BASINS MUST MEET THE REQUIREMENTS OF SECTION 10.3.8.4 OF MSD'S DESIGN MANUAL.

PUBLIC WORKS NOTES

1. ALL HANDICAP SITE FEATURES SHALL BE CONSTRUCTED IN ACCORDANCE WITH ACCEPTABLE "A.D.A." REQUIREMENTS FOR HANDICAP ACCESSIBILITY. 2. THERE SHALL BE NO NEW LANDSCAPING WITHIN RIGHT OF WAY WITHOUT ENCROACHMENT PERMIT.

3. CONSTRUCTION PLANS AND BONDS ARE REQUIRED BY PUBLIC WORKS PRIOR TO CONSTRUCTION APPROVAL AND ISSUANCE OF THE METRO PUBLIC WORKS ENCROACHMENT PERMIT. 4. ALL WALKS ARE MINIMUM 5 FOOT.

8. ALL SIGNS SHALL BE IN ACCORDANCE WITH CHAPTER 8 OF THE LDC. 9. ALL CONSTRUCTION TRAILERS MUST BE PERMITTED BY THE DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC HEALTH & WELLNESS IN ACCORDANCE WITH CHAPTER 115 OF LOUISVILLE JEFFERSON COUNTY METRO ORDINANCES.
