
### Who We Are

  - Juvenile Detention Alternative Initiative (JDAI)


#### Who We Are

#### What We Do

#### **Community Based Services**

- Home Supervision Program (HSP)
  - With House Arrest juveniles only attend school
  - Without House Arrest juveniles attend school; accompanied by a parent/guardian on all other activities
    - Capacity 50

ADP 43/ALOS 46 days

- Home Incarceration Program (HIP)
  - 24/7 electronic monitoring via GPS
  - Court ordered releases only
    - Capacity 70

ADP 39/ALOS 32 days

- YMCA Safe Place Services (STARR Program)
  - Contracted for court ordered emergency shelter services for Domestic Violence IV offenses
  - Parent involved case management
    - Capacity 3

ADP 1/ALOS 14 days (approx.)

- 96 bed capacity; contracted by the Kentucky Department of Juvenile Justice
- On-site JCPS Alternative School
  - Full-Time Assistant Principal
  - Six Certified Full-Time Teachers/ECE
  - Arts Program
  - Physical Education

#### On-Site Mental Health Services

- Master's Level Licensed Mental Health Professional
- Psychiatrist
- Community Support care from Our Lady of Peace (OLOP), The Brook, and Centerstone

#### On-Site Medical Services

- UL contracted Physicians
- Full-time Registered Nurse/Health Service Administrator
- Kosair Children Hospital for emergent care
