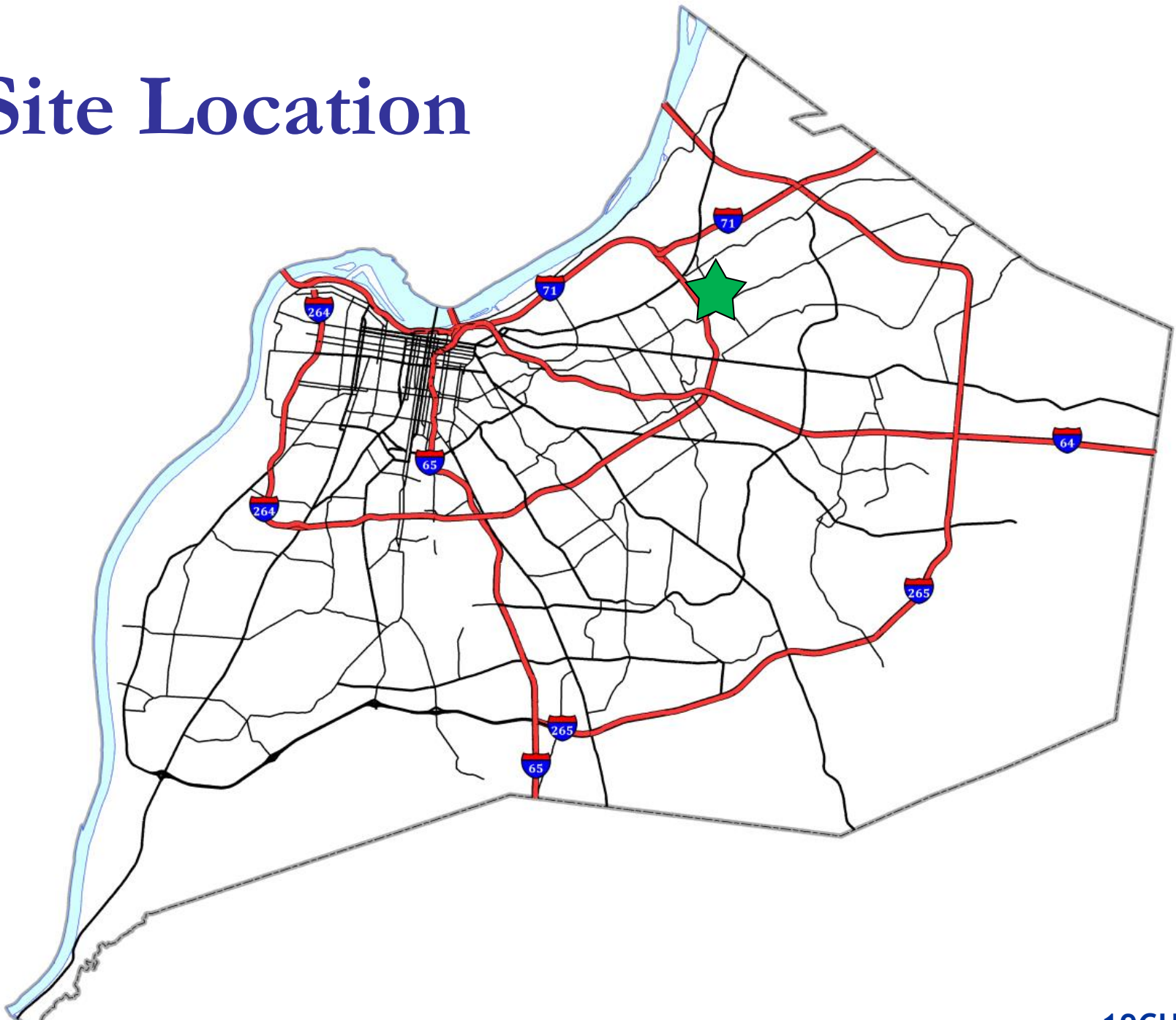

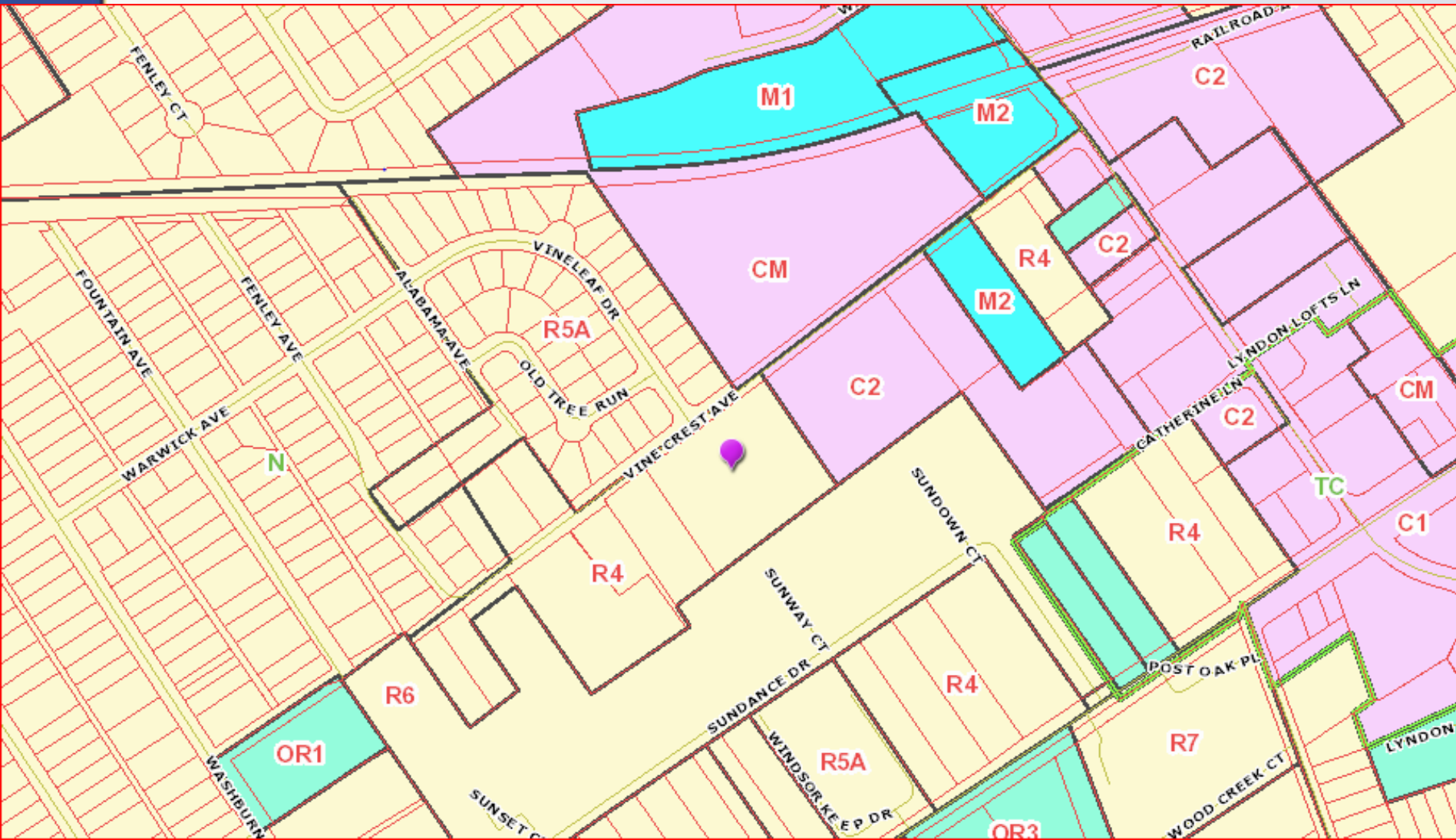

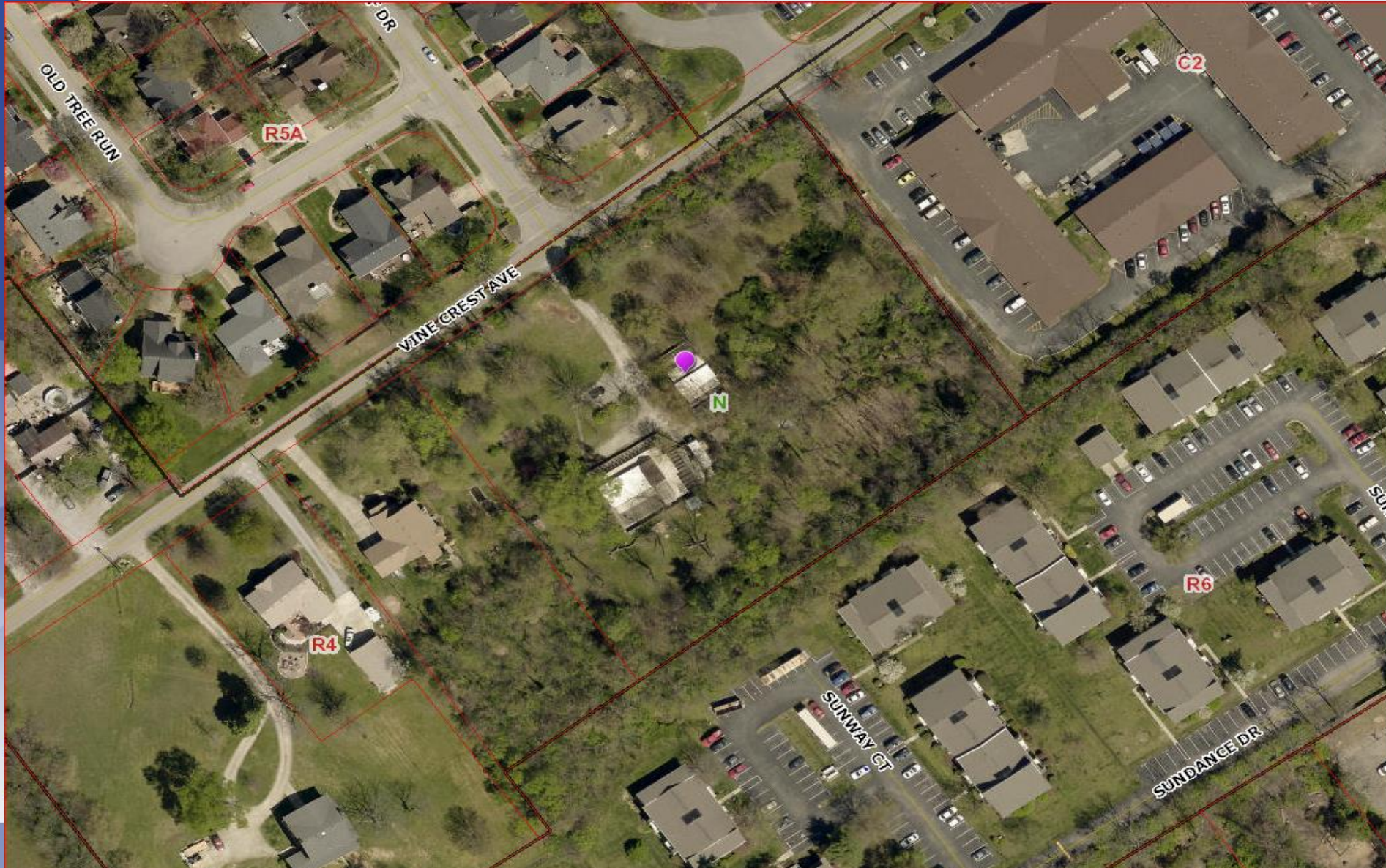
Site Location



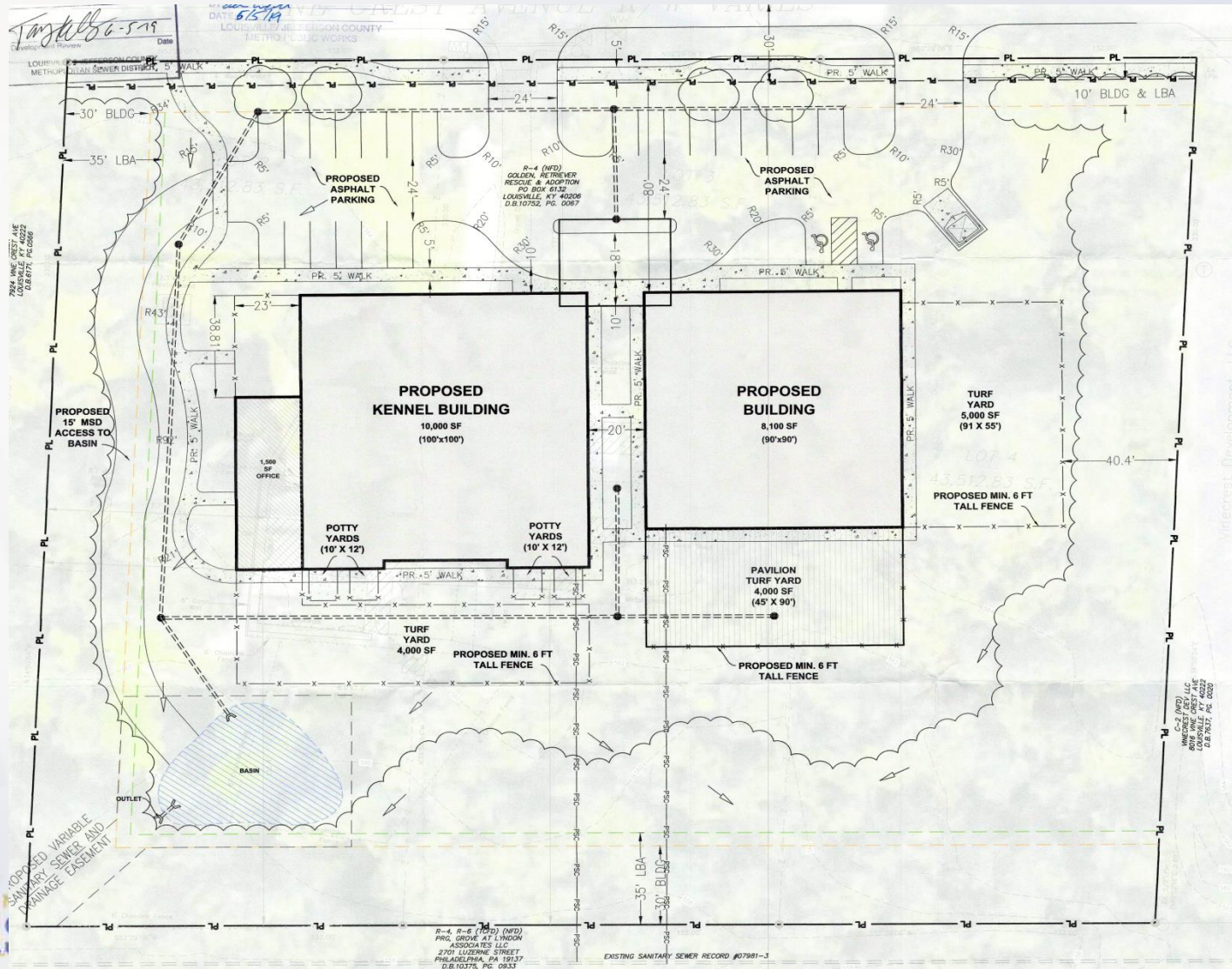
Zoning Map

Case Summary / Background

Modification of an existing Conditional Use Permit

“Special Use” permit was issued in 1947 for a dog kennel, 9-101-47.

Zoned R-4

Neighborhood Form District

City of Lyndon

Approximately 3 acres

Proposed:

10,000 square foot dog day care plus 1,500 square foot office,
two 120 square foot potty yards within a 4,000 square foot turf yard.
8,100 square foot kennel with 5,000 square foot turf yard and 4,000
pavilion turf yard.

Minimum 6 foot high privacy fence.
