#### Wanda,

This alley may be expensive depending on what CW Sexton Smith wants. The East and west portion of Eddy Ave is asphalt in poor condition. I recommend milling 1.5 inch and replacing 1.5 inches. The leg of this alley that Jeff highlighted that runs north of Eddy to Cedar St is gravel. If you want this leg done, we will need to reconstruct to provide a proper asphalt section which will consist of 12 inch excavation, replacement of 4 inches of KY# 3 stone, 4 inches of dense graded aggregate and 4 inches of asphalt.

With ramps I estimate that the east and west portion of Eddy street with cost \$15,000.00 while
