Good afternoon Principal Green,

Public Works prepared an estimate totaling \$31,000 to repair curbs and sidewalk along 11th St from Chestnut St to Magazine St.

In addition, they inspected the road conditions on this stretch of 11th St and made the following list of potential improvements:

- 1. Install curb bump outs at the 11th & Chestnut and 11th & Magazine intersections.
- 2. Pave 11th from Chestnut St to Magazine St.
- 3. Stripe the road way so there are 11' driving lanes and 8' parking lanes. The 8' lanes next to the curbs may need to be some other kind of lane besides parking that would narrow the driving

lane. Currently there no stopping signs near the school drop off point. (Principal Green—I know you mentioned interest in bike lane here. Perhaps that could be discussed.)

4. Install school crossing signs at 11th & Chestnut and 11th & Magazine, on 11th St.

I was informed that at this time, funding is not available for these improvements.

But this could be an important first step as we now have a scope of the issue. I would propose communicating with JCPS administration and CW Barbara Sexton Smith. JCPS may have knowledge of some grants. CW Sexton Smith may have some funding in next year's budget.

Good afternoon Jeff,

Today, I met with Principal Green (copied here) at Central High School to discuss the installation of a historical marker.

After we concluded that discussion, Principal Green wanted to relay some infrastructures issues that they have related to two things—1) curb deterioration on 11th and Chestnut streets and 2) challenges with their student drop off on 11th Street.

- 1. Central High School borders 11th & Chestnut streets. On both streets, the curbs are in poor shape. In many places, grass has grown through and in some places, the curb is nonexistent. Are these curbs and/or sidewalks in line for repair or replacement?
- 2. Two years ago, the Kentucky Department of Education did not approve of the manner in which Central students being dropped off in car were walking in to school through any entrance. A more structured plan was needed. Students now being dropped off in cars enter on 11th Street. Even though this plan is KDE approved and makes sense for the layout of the school, Central administration fears that, due to the condition of 11th Street, it will only be a matter of time until a child is hurt exiting the car and walking into school. Conditions on this stretch of 11th (between Chestnut and Magazine) includes no painted lane lines, some potholes, curbs in disrepair, (administration reports) poor lighting, and because this is a two way road, parents are using both sides of the road to drop kids off and some kids are crossing the street in a Frogger like attempt. A member of Central's staff operates as cross guard of sorts beginning at 7 a.m. on school days but there are limited in their ability to control drivers and pedestrians. Is this stretch of 11th due for repairing or repairs? I say all this certainly knowing that we are limited in available funds to make repairs and improvements but as it deals with the safety of our students, I am hoping that the appropriate parties may get together to determine what may be the best action moving forward. Principal Green may also bring Councilwoman Sexton Smith to see what guidance she may offer.

Could you please assist Central with these infrastructure challenges? Thank you!
