- 4TH GRADE CURRICULUM ON EMOTIONS/COPING STRATEGIES



- HEALTH CLINICS AT 4 SCHOOLS (2 NEW IN FY20)

- 8 REGULAR DENTAL CLINICS AND MULTIPLE EPISODIC CLINICS

RACIAL EQUITY POLICY



- Passed in May 2018
- AIMED AT IMPROVING EDUCATIONAL OUTCOMES FOR STUDENTS OF COLOR AND SHRINKING THE ACHIEVEMENT GAP.
- JCPS IS 1 OF ONLY 11 PUBLIC SCHOOL DISTRICT IN THE COUNTRY TO PASS SUCH A POLICY
