AN ORDINANCE APPROPRIATING \$18,344.40 FROM DISTRICT 8 NEIGHBORHOOD DEVELOPMENT FUNDS TO SOLID WASTE MANAGEMENT FOR A LITTER PICK UP AND STREET SWEEPING PROGRAM ALONG THE BARDSTOWN ROAD AND BAXTER AVENUE CORRIDOR FROM JUNE 15, 2019 TO SEPTEMBER 4, 2019.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL OF THE LOUISVILLE/JEFFERSON COUNTY METRO GOVERNMENT (THE COUNCIL) AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION I: The sum of \$18,344.40 is hereby appropriated from District 8

Neighborhood Development Funds to Solid Waste Management for a litter pick up and

street sweeping program along the Bardstown Road and Baxter Avenue Corridor from

Broadway to Harvard Drive, providing litter pick up twice weekly and street sweeping

once every two weeks from June 15, 2019 to September 4, 2019.

SECTION II: The Council has determined the funds requested in this ordinance will be expended for a public purpose.

SECTION III: This grant is subject to the Council's Policies and Procedures as adopted and effective at the date of passage of this Ordinance.

SECTION IV: This Ordinance shall take effect upon its passage and approval.
