We have had several cancellations due to the breakdowns and the uncertainty of the continued operation of the system.

That we, the undersigned, citizens of the United States and of the State of Kentucky, have this day voluntarily associated ourselves together for the purpose of forming a non-profit corporation under the laws of the State of Kentucky, pursuant to Chapter 273 of the Kentucky Revised Statutes, and to that end do hereby adopt Articles of Incorporation as follows:

Article I. Name

The name of the corporation shall be Wilder Park Association, Inc.

Article II. Duration

The period of duration of Wilder Park Association, Inc. shall be perpetual.

Article III. Purposes

Wilder Park Association. Inc., is organized exclusively for charitable purposes, to wit, the lessening of the burdens of local government by combatting deterioration and juvenile delinquency, by assisting the alderly, the youth and the handicapped, and by promoting and fostering programs and projects to enhance the health and safety of the inhabitants of the community, including for such purposes, the making of distributions to organizations that qualify as exempt organizations under section 501 (c) (3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1954 (or the corresponding provision of any future United States Revenue Law).

Article IV. Non-Profit/Tax-Exempt Status

No part of the net earnings of Wilder Park Association, Inc., shall inure to the benefit of, or be distributable to its Members, Directors, Officers, or other private persons, except that Kilder Frik Association, Inc., shall be authorized and empowered to pay reasonable compensation for services rendered and to make payments and distributions in furtherance of the purposes set forth in Article III hereof. No substantial part of the activities of Wilder Park Association, Inc., shall be the carrying on of propaganda, or otherwise attempting to influence legislation, and Wilder Park Association, Inc., shall not participate in, or intervene in (including the publication or distribution of statements) any political campaign on behalf of any candidate for public office. Notwithstanding any other provision of these Articles, the Wilder Park Association, Inc., shall not carry on any other activities not permitted to be carried on (a) by a corporation exempt from federal income tax under section 501 (c) (3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1954 (or the corresponding provision of any future United States

Article VIII. Amendments to Articles

The Articles of Incorporation of Wilder Park Association, Inc., may be amended by either written consent of a majority of its Members or by a vote of a majority of those Members who are present and voting at a meeting duly called upon notice for the specific purpose of amending the Articles.

Article IX. Liabilities

Members of Wilder Park Association, Inc., shall not be personally liable for any debt or other financial obligation solely by reason of boing Members of said corporation.

Article X. Powers of Board of Directors

The Board of Directors shall possess all of the powers necessary to effectuate the purposes of Wilder Park Association, Inc., and shall exercise complete control and management thereof, limited only by the rights and powers vested in the Members by these Articles, and the laws of the State of Kentucky, and the limitations imposed by Articles III, IV and V hereof.


