Per our discussion on your needs for the property strip map and topographic survey along Phillips Lane, I have put together this cost estimate. A topographic survey of the two areas you need for the sidewalk project will take a field crew about a 12 hours to collect. Field collection of any needed property corners for the Phillips Lane corridor will be 4 hours. The field crew will establish horizontal and vertical survey control. Locate the topographic features such as: edge of pavement, crown of road, driveway, ditch-lines, culverts, berms, swales and other topographic features. In order to accurately tie down property boundaries for the owners adjacent to the roadway. For the entire corridor We plan to pull the deeds and associated plats, draft the descriptions and lot lines, create stake out points to look for exiting corners to rotate lines to and establish a strip map of the properties. Planning and office preparation for the field work will be 4 hours, property resolution will be about 6 hours. We will call KY811 and locate any utilities marked in the field to include in the digital basemap. Drafting the features in a useable Microstation DGN with associated DTM file will be 8 hours for final delivery. Our field survey files will be merged with any LOJIC basemap you provide and will include the survey points for your use. All these services will be managed by a licensed professional and survey manager and delivered within 30 days of a authorizing purchase order.

The total cost for the topographic survey at Philips lane is \$1,900, and the property strip map cost is \$3,500 for a total combine cost of \$5,400.
