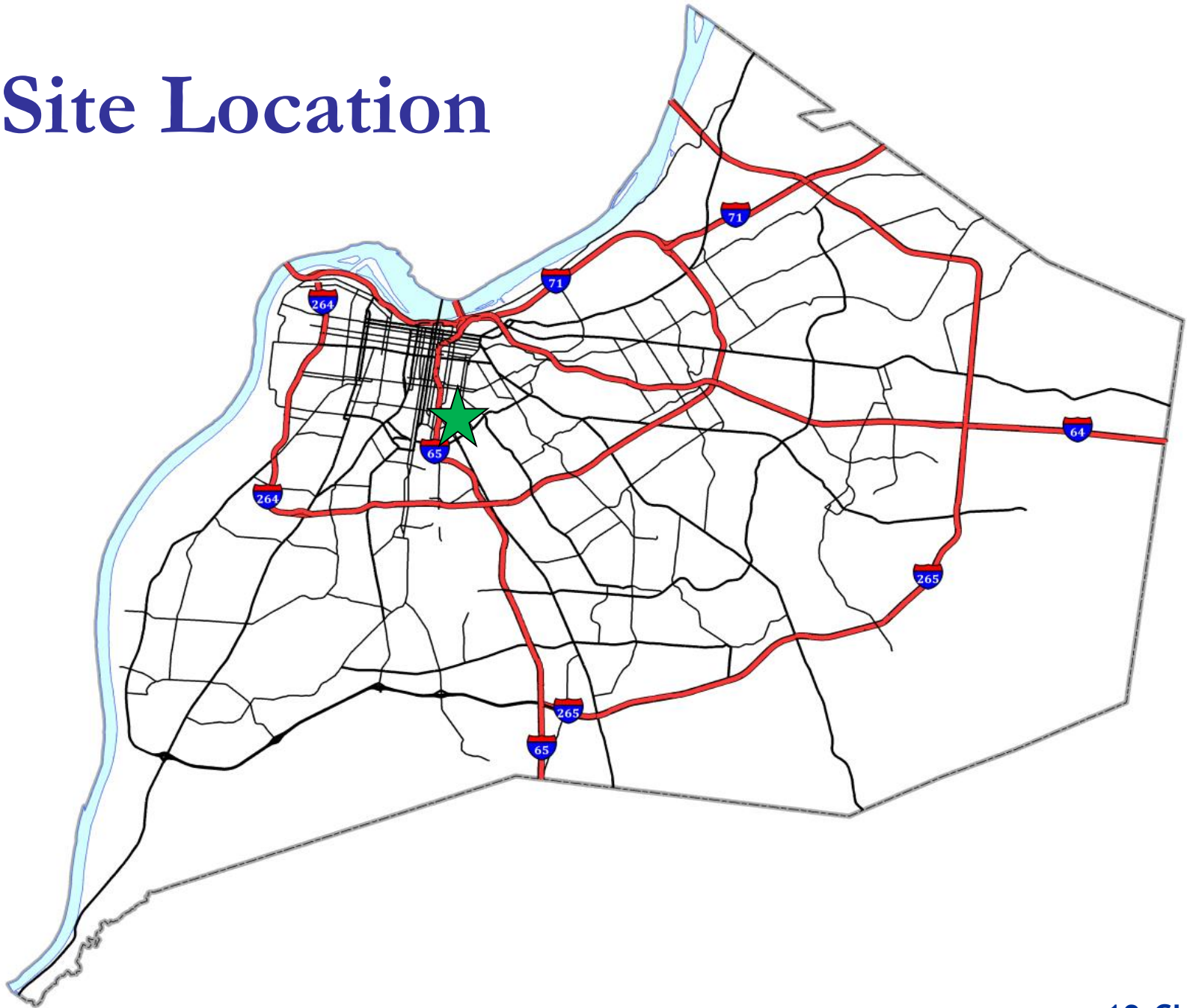
Request(s)

- Conditional Use Permit to allow short term rental of a dwelling unit that is not the primary residence of the host.

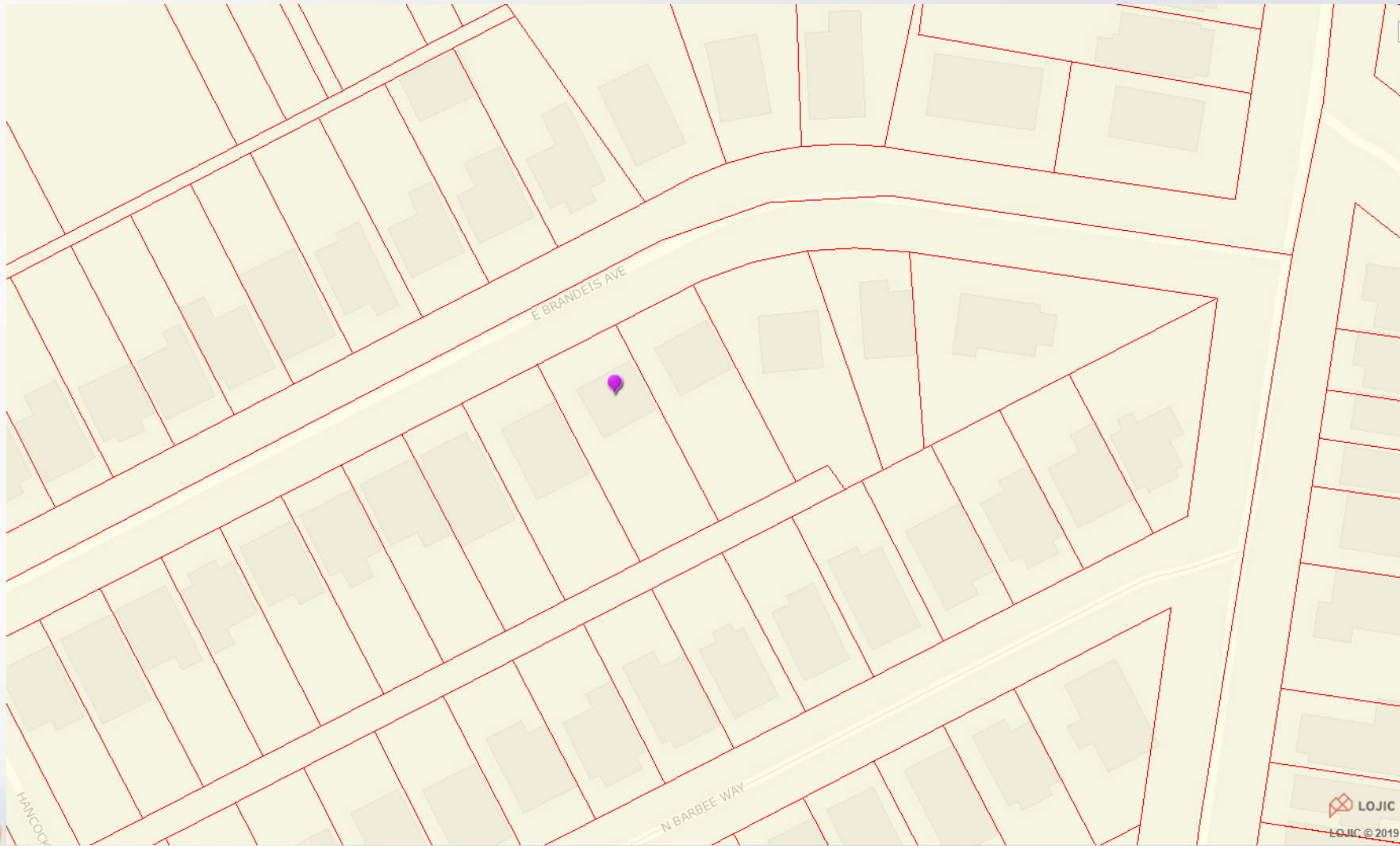
Case Summary/Background

Site Location

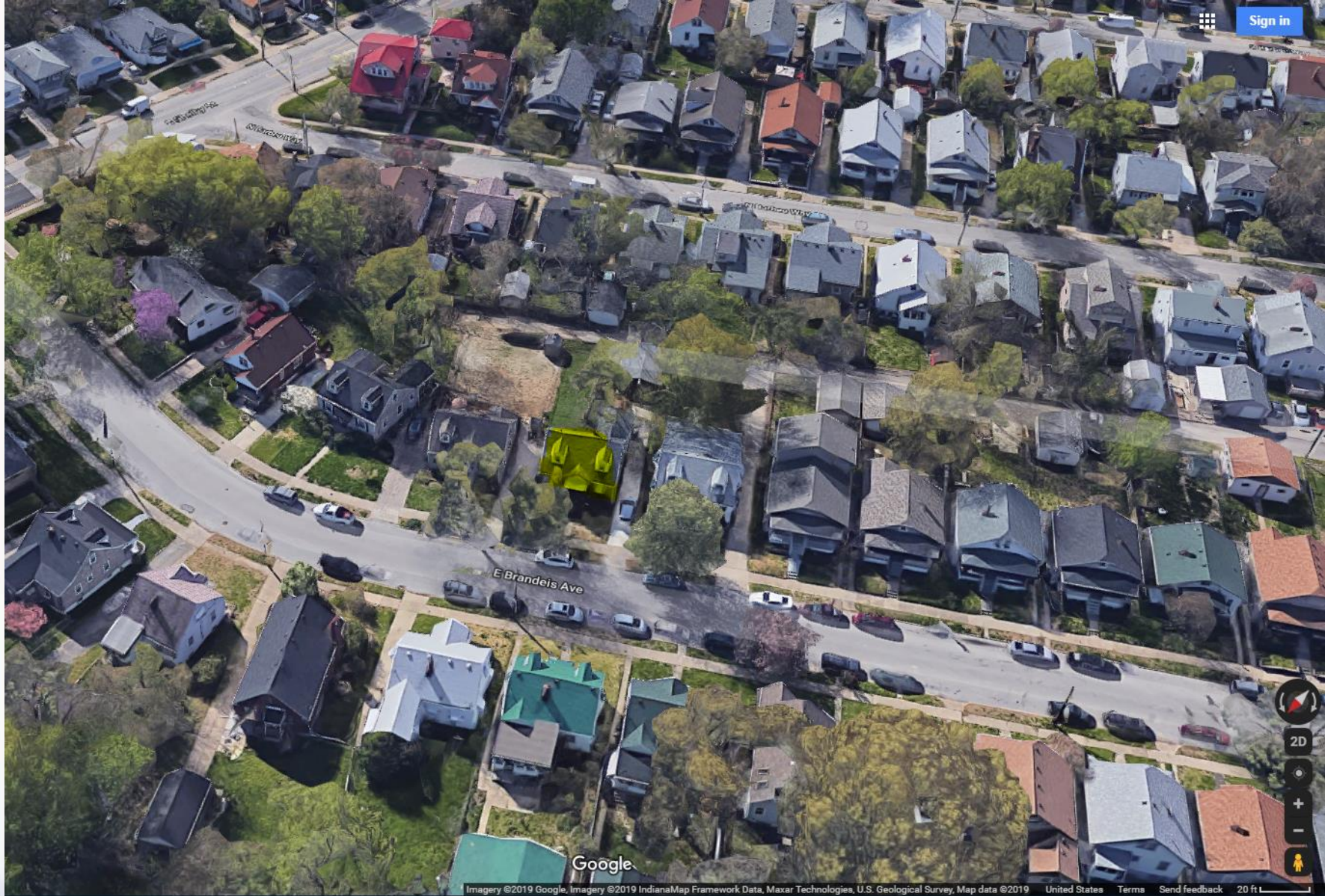


Zoning/Form Districts

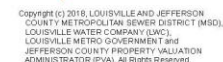
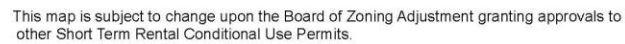
