Good afternoon,

Sorry, the available \$30,000.00 Neighborhood Infrastructure and Safety Plan matching funds have now been decreased to **\$21,500.00**. Therefore, D1, D3 and D6 will now need to contribute a total of \$38,500.00 CIF funds toward the comprehensive plan (estimate \$12,833.34 each district).

After Justin responded to us on Oct. 17, 2019, he learned that Metro Council had approved project #75 for \$15,000.00 Development Feasibility Study near Brentlinger Lane in the FY19 Capital Budget under Public Works but the match funding account is under Develop Louisville.

According to Justin, Develop Louisville didn't know about the feasibility study referenced in the FY19 Capital Budget; therefore, no paperwork or information was communicated to Justin to restrict the \$15k for the feasibility study. The district requesting the feasibility study had been working with Beth on trying to locate where the \$15k is recorded over the past few months prior to her leaving. Recently, I inquired with Justin about the district's missing \$15k match and he did some additional research and determined that the funds are recorded in the Neighborhood Infrastructure and Safety Plan matching funds.
