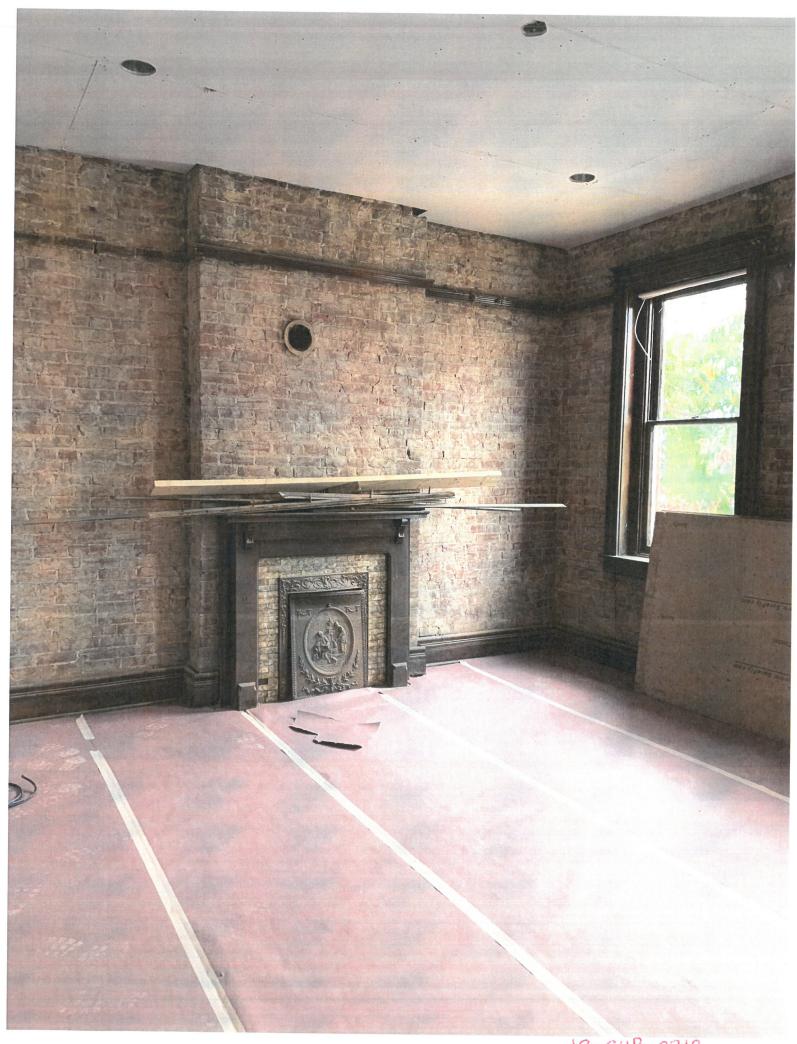

Summary:

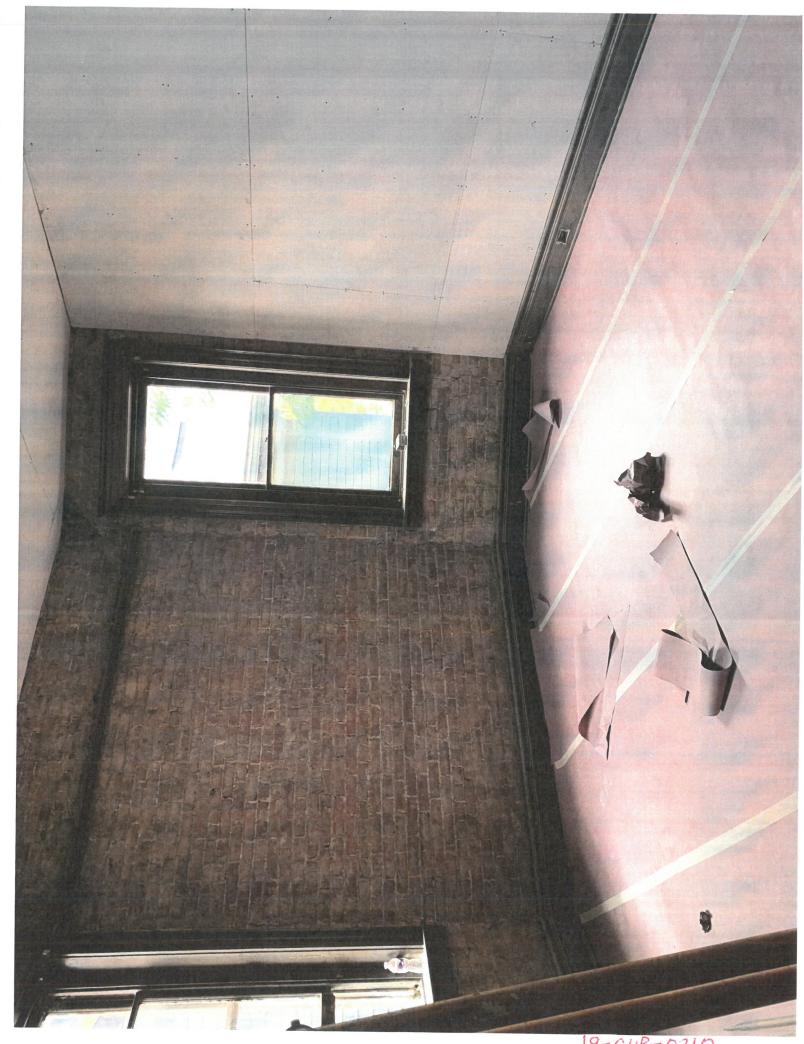
