Subject: Baxter/Bardstown Rd from Broadway to Dundee crosswalk markings

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Councilman Coan has funded some safety improvements for the Bardstown Rd corridor based on the recommendations in the <u>Safety Study</u>. Right now we are just looking for a small scale, inexpensive project to enhance pedestrian safety. I am proposing to add crosswalks at all of the stop controlled side street intersections between Broadway & Dundee and enhance a few of the signalized intersections with bar walks. In addition, we are also proposing to refresh all of the existing marked crosswalks & bar walks with the exception of Highland & Bardstown, Grinstead & Bardstown and Eastern Pkwy & Bardstown.

Attached is a spreadsheet with a description of the proposed work and an exhibit showing the first 6 intersections as an example.

Here's a quick note on the proposed changes:

Adding yield bars at two of the existing mid-block school crossings near Edenside and at Alfresco Enhancing the off-set Bonnycastle intersections crosswalks with bar walks but they may not be equipped with audible peds.

Just let me know what I need to do to get this project started. Did you want to issue a permit?
