Committee Member Green stated they introduced an ordinance several months ago amending sections 37.65-37.69 of the Louisville Metro Code of Ordinances relating to Minority, Female, Disabled Owned Business Enterprise and adding a section for Lesbian, Gay, Bisexual, and Transgender Owned Business. She stated one of the first things that they did was clean-up the language and changed "Handicap" to "Disable" so that it is non-controversial. She also said as a city we will prioritize in giving business to businesses that are owned by LGBT businesses. She stated it is not controversial it just make business since and a compassionate city. She stated in her mind it is nothing wrong with us making an intentional effort to try to send some contracts to the businesses and it does not specify the amount of businesses. She welcome Johnathan Lovitiz from the National LGBT Chamber of Commerce and stated she was honor that he thought enough of them to come and join them. She asked him to introduce his team.
