SECTION I: Chapter 1 of the LDC, Section 1.2.2 – Definitions, is amended to add the following definitions:

Tobacco and/or Vape Shop – a retail store required by Chapter 90 of the Louisville Metro Code of Ordinances to be licensed as a Tobacco Retailer and/or Vapor Product Retail Store.

SECTION II: Chapter 4 of the LDC, Part 3 – Permitted Use with Standards, is amended to add the following:

4.3.24 Tobacco and/or Vape Shop

In the C-1, C-2, C-3, C-M, EZ-1, and PEC zoning districts, Tobacco and/or Vape Shops may be permitted in accordance with the following special standards:

- A. No Tobacco and/or Vape Shop shall be located within one thousand (1,000) feet of the boundary of any parcel occupied by any of the following uses (as measured in a straight line from parcel boundary to parcel boundary):
 - 1. Public or private early childhood, elementary, middle or high school
 - 2. Park
 - 3. Public playground
 - 4. Recreation (Use), Outdoor
 - 5. Community Center
 - 6. Day Care Center
 - 7. Athletic Facility, Indoor and Outdoor
- B. No Tobacco and/or Vape Shop shall be located within six hundred (600) feet of a site occupied by another Tobacco and/or Vape Shop, as measured in a straight line from parcel boundary to parcel boundary. This separation requirement is eligible for a waiver in accordance with Chapter 11, Part 8 of the LDC.
- C. The hours of operation for a Tobacco and/or Vape Shop shall be no earlier than six (6) A.M. and no later than ten (10) P.M., seven (7) days a week. The hours of operation requirement is eligible for a waiver in accordance with Chapter 11, Part 8 of the LDC.
