- 1. further down (away from Lakeside on other side of Dundee) Trevilian Way
- 2. Lexington Rd west of Grinstead Dr for WB traffic
- 3. Trevilian Way for EB traffic receiving from Newburg Rd.

The fastest we will be able to make this happen is about a month or a month and a half. We will have to determine a good location, draw up a plan and then schedule installation. We will do our best but we currently have a lot of other projects going on.
