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Thanks! My comments as follows:

I applaud the reduced height of this building as it is much more sympathetic with the structures on this block. However, reducing the frontage to extend towards Cherokee Road is a gross encroachment on the road and significantly detracts from the greenway feel that complements the park on the other side .

Moreover, the allowance of *any* variance should require an incredibly strong rationale. With the exception of personal profit, I do not see any here. The neighbors all bear the negative externalities and the owner? None. There could be a perfectly fine multi-family dwelling built here without variances – so why allow it?

This effort has taken up the Planning Commission's agenda (and concerned citizen's time and attention) on multiple occasions and it's been clear that the Commission has provided sound judgement to maintain the current building codes so why waver now? You are opening yourself up to future log-jams of similar re-applications. Again, a worrisome precedent.
