Thanks for expressing your concerns regarding this proposal. I will add it to the file and make it available for BOZA to review prior to the hearing.

I did want to make you aware that on the latest plan the applicant is no longer requesting a sidewalk waiver but will instead do a fee-in-lieu or construct offsite in consultation with Public Works.

Also, we did have them add a note about the alley, essentially the decision will be up to LFD if they think they can serve it adequately with the current alley or not. The final decision would be made during construction planning.
