The following was discussed:

- Changing from announcement-based to appointment-based junk pickup, Public Works can offer either option
- Complexes with more than eight units would have to be serviced by a Commercial provider, pre-existing pickup agreement would be honored
- Paper bags, yard waste, and vacuuming leaves
- Nine times per year drop off locations all across the city
- Implementation of the program
- The pilot program in regards to communication and enforcement
- Possible need for more staff
- Codes and Regulation staff would also be trained to help spread the word about the program
- Metro 311 not an option right now with the appointment process, but may be later
- Stickers provided to put on containers of reusable waste
- Question about “pickers” who rummage through bulky waste to make use of items and whether this program will eliminate that
- Pop-off/drop-offs occurring nine times a year for those in areas outside the Urban Service District, and the contributions from the Waste Management District for this service

A motion was made by Committee Member Hollander, seconded by Chair Coan, to table this Ordinance. The motion carried by a voice vote.
