Charles,

The alley in question near 1041 to 1045 S43rd St is currently asphalt with a lot of vegetative growth through cracks. I suggest 2 inch mill and overlay with fiber reinforced asphalt. No sidewalk ramps need to be updated. Coming up with an estimate of \$6,000 00 for this section.

The section just south of Grand Ave from 1047 to 1053 is currently gravel. To convert to an asphalt alley, I suggest a 12 inch excavation, replacement with 4 inches of KY #3 stone covered with 4" of DGA, and then 4" of asphalt. Coming up with a cost of \$12,500.00 for this small section.

Total for both sections would be \$18,500.00.
