Total cost would be \$4,500.00 for all of the materials.

We would have 3<sup>rd</sup> shift change these out at night. It looks like all of the conduit system and service is in good shape.

I had a work order created to go down and look at his tonight to see what is working and make sure we have power to them.


With that in mind, a donation of \$2250.00 has been approved in order to help sufficiently light the aforementioned underpass.
