CW McCraney / LaTonya,

From time to time, I have conversations with KYTC D5 about a multitude of sidewalk gaps throughout the city. Recently, we spoke about the missing gap piece on the west side of New LaGrange Road (see picture below). I mentioned to them that maybe we could partner up (50/50) at times and try to connect up some of these gaps. So I have priced this project using Metro's New Sidewalk contract. I am not sure if something like this would require an official MOA (Memorandum of Agreement) with KYTC.

The new sidewalk estimate here would be **\$13,000**. This would include costs for a 5-foot wide concrete sidewalk (with a grass verge), seeding & protection, Mobilization, MOT items and a small contingency. That would be \$6,500 for D7 and \$6,500 for KYTC D5.

KYTC has already informed me about their acceptance to move forward with this project.
