We would like to suggest some binding elements for the PC to hear this Thursday. They are below.

The subject property shall only be used for uses allowed in the C-N Commercial Neighborhood zoning district and the following uses allowed in the C-1 Commercial zoning district:

- 1. Pet shop
- 2. Paint Store
- 3. Music Store
- 4. Pet grooming, obedience training and related pet activities, provided the operation is conducted within a soundproofed building, no animals are boarded, and there are no runs or pens outside of the building.
- 5. Package liquor stores (no on-site alcohol consumption allowed)
- 6. Furniture Stores
- 7. Computer sales (hardware and software) and programming services
- 8. Conditional uses allowed in the C-1 Commercial zoning district under Chapter 4, Part 2, except for "Outdoor Alcohol Sales and Consumption/Entertainment Activity for Restaurants in the C-1 zoning district" under Chapter 4, Part 2.41

The applicant shall screen any mechanical equipment on the east side of the proposed building through the use of a fence, landscaping, or combination thereof, as approved by the Louisville Metro Planning Staff as part of the required landscape plan.

The applicant shall provide, at its expense, a planting screen in the front yard of the property located at 916 Fountain Avenue if so requested by the owner of said property.
