## Variance Justification:

The existing sign has been in place for over 50 years. We are simply changing the sign panel on top with a new logo and replacing the lower portion reader board with a new EMC, which is a definite upgrade.

There are other signs in the area. This sign will be an upgrade that will allow for better communication, improve the aesthetic of the site, and provide a more up-to-date medium.

The existing sign has been in place for over 50 years. The size and shape of the sign are not changing. The proposes sign only serves as an important upgrade to the outreach and information work of the church.

This sign and the church have been a part of and served the community for years. The general vicinity has received numerous upgrades and enhancements over that time. Allowing the church an upgraded sign will only improve the ability of the church to serve the community.

No. It is strictly due to our changing technological times. This method of communicating with the community is more informative, flexible, and in-depth than the existing static reader board.
