Neighborhood Development Funds, through the Office of Management and Budget, to the City of Middletown to provide needed safety equipment for the Middletown

Police Department mobile radio upgrades and ballistic helmets with face shields for the Middletown Police Department.

SECTION II: The Council has determined the funds requested in this Ordinance will be expended for a public purpose.

SECTION III: This grant is subject to the Council's Policies and Procedures as adopted and effective at the date of passage of this Ordinance.
